AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to access to recorded
personal medical information

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The insurance law is amended by adding a new section 323 to
2 read as follows:
3 S 323. ACCESS TO PERSONAL MEDICAL INFORMATION. IF AN INDIVIDUAL, AFTER
4 PROPER IDENTIFICATION, SUBMITS A WRITTEN REQUEST TO AN INSURANCE INSTI-
5 TUTION, AGENT, OR INSURANCE-SUPPORT ORGANIZATION FOR ACCESS TO RECORDED
6 PERSONAL MEDICAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE INDIVIDUAL WHICH INFORMATION IS
7 REASONABLY DESCRIBED BY THE INDIVIDUAL, THE INSURANCE INSTITUTION, AGENT
8 OR INSURANCE-SUPPORT ORGANIZATION MAY CHARGE A REASONABLE FEE, NOT TO
9 EXCEED ONE DOLLAR PER PAGE, TO BE PAID BY THE PERSON MAKING SUCH REQUEST
10 TO COVER THE COSTS INCURRED IN PROVIDING A COPY OF THE RECORDED PERSONAL
11 MEDICAL INFORMATION TO SUCH INDIVIDUAL.
12 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of September next
13 succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
