AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to sudden, unexpected death in epilepsy

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 4210 of the public health law is amended by adding 2 a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:

- 5. WHEN AN AUTOPSY OF THE BODY IS CONDUCTED OF A DECEASED HUMAN WHO HAS EPILEPSY OR A HISTORY OF SEIZURES IT SHALL INCLUDE AN INVESTIGATION AND DETERMINATIONS AS TO WHETHER THE DECEASED SUFFERED A SUDDEN UNEXPECTED DEATH IN EPILEPSY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH STANDARDS ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSIONER. IN THE EVENT THE DECEASED DID SUFFER A SUDDEN, UNEXPECTED DEATH IN EPILEPSY, SUCH INFORMATION SHALL BE NOTED ON THE MEDICAL CERTIFICATE AND BE REPORTED TO THE DEPARTMENT WITHIN THREE BUSINESS DAYS.
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 12 it shall have become a law; provided, however, that effective immediate-13 ly, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation 14 necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date is 15 authorized and directed to be made and completed on or before such 16 effective date.
