AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to observance of certain holidays by institutions within the state university and the city university of New York

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 362 to  
2 read as follows:

3 S 362. HOLIDAYS TO BE OBSERVED. NO CLASS OR ANY OTHER COURSE OF  
4 INSTRUCTION SHALL BE HELD IN ANY INSTITUTION WITHIN THE STATE UNIVERSITY  
5 ON THOSE DAYS OF RELIGIOUS OBSERVANCE KNOWN AS EID UL-FITR, EID UL-ADHA,  
6 DIWALI AND THE ASIAN LUNAR NEW YEAR, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT THE CHAN-  
7 CELLOR, IN HIS OR HER DISCRETION, MAY EXEMPT ANY INSTITUTION FROM THE  
8 FOREGOING PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

9 S 2. The education law is amended by adding a new section 6235 to read  
10 as follows:

11 S 6235. HOLIDAYS TO BE OBSERVED. NO CLASS OR ANY OTHER COURSE OF  
12 INSTRUCTION SHALL BE HELD IN ANY INSTITUTION WITHIN THE CITY UNIVERSITY  
13 ON THOSE DAYS OF RELIGIOUS OBSERVANCE KNOWN AS EID UL-FITR, EID UL-ADHA,  
14 DIWALI AND THE ASIAN LUNAR NEW YEAR PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT THE CHANCEL-  
15 LOR, IN HIS OR HER DISCRETION, MAY EXEMPT ANY INSTITUTION FROM THE FORE-  
16 GOING PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

17 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
