AN ACT to amend the uniform justice court act, in relation to establishing minimum educational requirements of certain town and village justices

PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-THE BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The uniform justice court act is amended by adding a new section 105-a to read as follows:

S 105-A. MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS OF CERTAIN TOWN AND VILLAGE JUSTICES.

NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, OR VILLAGE, MAY BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF SUCH TOWN OR VILLAGE, REQUIRE THAT ANY PERSON WHO SERVES AS A TOWN OR VILLAGE JUSTICE ADMITTED TO PRACTICE LAW IN THE STATE. ANY CHANGE IN THE REQUIRE-MENTS FOR ELIGIBILITY TO SERVE AS TOWN OR VILLAGE JUSTICE SHALL EFFECT UPON COMMENCEMENT OF THE NEXT JUDICIAL TERM OF OFFICE FOLLOWING
