AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to criminal possession of a firearm or magazine digitally made

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 265.00 of the penal law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 26 to read as follows:
  - 26. "FIREARM OR MAGAZINE DIGITALLY MADE" MEANS ANY FIREARM OR MAGAZINE THAT IS PRODUCED USING DIGITAL MANUFACTURING TECHNOLOGIES INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, COMPUTER NUMERICAL CONTROL MILLS, THREE-DIMENSIONAL PRINTERS, AND LASER CUTTING MACHINES.
  - S 2. Section 265.02 of the penal law is amended by adding a new subdivision 4 to read as follows:
- 9 (4) SUCH PERSON KNOWINGLY POSSESSES AN UNDETECTABLE AND UNTRACEABLE 10 MACHINE-GUN, FIREARM OR MAGAZINE DIGITALLY MADE AS DEFINED BY SUBDIVI-11 SION TWENTY-SIX OF SECTION 265.00 OF THIS ARTICLE, RIFLE OR SHOTGUN
- 12 WHOSE FRAME OR RECEIVER IS COMPOSED OF OR BUILT WITH OR MANUFACTURED
- 13 WITH OR FABRICATED WITH MATERIALS THAT ARE NOT DETECTABLE BY A METAL 14 DETECTOR OR MAGNETOMETER WHEN SET AT STANDARD CALIBRATION; OR
