AN ACT to authorize the city of Mount Vernon, in the county of Westchester, to offer certain retirement options to Christopher Grieco, Wendell Griffin, Patsy Leone and Jeremy Villanueva, police officers employed by such city

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,  
2     the city of Mount Vernon, in the county of Westchester, a participating  
3     employer in the New York state and local police and fire retirement  
4     system, which previously elected to offer the optional retirement plan  
5     established pursuant to section 384-d of the retirement and social security law to police officers employed by such city, is hereby authorized  
6     to make participation in such plan available to Christopher Grieco,  
7     Wendell Griffin, Patsy Leone and Jeremy Villanueva, police officers  
8     employed by the city of Mount Vernon, who, on the effective date of this  
9     act are covered under the provisions of section 375-i of the retirement  
10    and social security law, and who, for reasons not ascribable to their  
11    own negligence failed to make a timely application to participate in  
12    such optional retirement plan. The city of Mount Vernon may so elect by  
13    filing with the state comptroller, on or before June 30, 2014, a resolution of its legislative body together with certification that any such  
14    police officer did not bar himself or herself from participation in such  
15    retirement plan as a result of his or her own negligence. Thereafter,  
16    any such police officer may elect to be covered by the provisions of  
17    section 384-d of the retirement and social security law, and shall be  
18    entitled to the full rights and benefits associated with coverage under  
19    such section, by filing a request to that effect with the state comptroller on or before June 30, 2016.

20    S 2. All costs associated with implementing the provisions of this act  
21    shall be borne by the city of Mount Vernon.

22    S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
