

1 2. TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE G.I.V.E. BACK NY PROGRAM, A
2 CANDIDATE SHALL:

3 (A) BE HONORABLY DISCHARGED FROM THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES
4 WITH SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITIES AS DETERMINED BY THE UNITED STATES
5 DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS OR THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF
6 DEFENSE;

7 (B) BE UNEMPLOYED OR UNDEREMPLOYED;

8 (C) HAVE DEMONSTRATED AN INTEREST IN FUTURE EMPLOYMENT IN PUBLIC
9 SERVICE, GOVERNMENT OR PUBLIC POLICY; AND

10 (D) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE G.I.V.E. BACK NY
11 PROGRAM TO THE SENATE OR ASSEMBLY. SUCH APPLICATION SHALL BE MADE IN A
12 MANNER AND FORM AS DETERMINED BY THE SENATE AND THE ASSEMBLY.

13 3. IN AN EFFORT TO FOSTER AND ENCOURAGE PARTICIPATION IN THE G.I.V.E.
14 BACK NY PROGRAM, THE ASSEMBLY INTERN OFFICE AND THE SENATE INTERN OFFICE
15 SHALL COORDINATE WITH EACH OTHER AND WITH COUNTY VETERANS' SERVICES
16 AGENCIES TO IDENTIFY AND RECRUIT ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES.

17 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
