AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the dates for attendance of minors upon full day instruction

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph c of subdivision 1 of section 3205 of the tion law, as amended by chapter 518 of the laws of 1993, is amended to read as follows:

- c. For purposes of this article, a minor who becomes six years of age on or before the first of [December] NOVEMBER in any school year shall be required to attend upon full time instruction from the first day that 7 the appropriate public schools are in session in September of 8 school year, and a minor who becomes six years of age after the first of 9 [December] NOVEMBER in any school year shall be required to attend upon full time instruction from the first day of session in the following 10 September; and, except as otherwise provided in subdivision three of 11 12 this section, shall be required to remain in attendance until the 13 day of session in the school year in which the minor becomes sixteen years of age. 14
 - S 2. Paragraph c of subdivision 1 of section 3205 of the education amended by section one of this act, is amended to read as follows:
 - c. For purposes of this article, a minor who becomes six years of age on or before the first of [November] OCTOBER in any school year shall be required to attend upon full time instruction from the first day that the appropriate public schools are in session in September of such school year, and a minor who becomes six years of age after the first of [November] OCTOBER in any school year shall be required to attend upon full time instruction from the first day of session in the following September; and, except as otherwise provided in subdivision three of

- S 3. Paragraph c of subdivision 1 of section 3205 of the education law, as amended by section two of this act, is amended to read as follows:
- c. For purposes of this article, a minor who becomes six years of age on or before the first of [October] SEPTEMBER in any school year shall be required to attend upon full time instruction from the first day that the appropriate public schools are in session in September of such school year, and a minor who becomes six years of age after the first of [October] SEPTEMBER in any school year shall be required to attend upon full time instruction from the first day of session in the following 13 14 September; and, except as otherwise provided in subdivision three of 15 this section, shall be required to remain in attendance until the last 16 day of session in the school year in which the minor becomes sixteen 17 years of age.
 - Children affected by the changes to dates for attendance of 4. minors upon full day instruction provided for in sections one, two and three of this act shall be given priority placement in existing pre-kindergarten programs in the school district where the child resides.
- 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016; provided, however, 22 section two of this act shall take effect July 1, 2017; and, provided 23 24 further, section three of this act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
