AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to permitting a minor over twelve years of age to work as a referee for athletic games or competitions under certain circumstances

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 130 of the labor law is amended by adding a new paragraph i to read as follows:

  I. A MINOR OVER TWELVE YEARS OF AGE AS A REFEREE AT AN ATHLETIC GAME.
  - I. A MINOR OVER TWELVE YEARS OF AGE AS A REFEREE AT AN ATHLETIC GAME, COMPETITION OR TOURNAMENT, INVOLVING COMPETITORS WHO ARE TWELVE YEARS OF AGE OR YOUNGER, HOSTED BY AN ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION OR ORGANIZATION THAT HAS TRAINED AND TESTED SUCH MINOR IN ACCORDANCE WITH ESTABLISHED SAFETY STANDARDS, FOR A DURATION OF TWENTY HOURS OR LESS PER WEEK AND DURING TIMES WHEN SCHOOL IS NOT IN SESSION AND THE MINOR IS ACCOMPANIED BY THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN.
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
