AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring all playgrounds be equipped with live digital security systems with a live feed to the nearest law enforcement agency

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The administrative code of the city of New York is amended 2 by adding a new section 10-109 to read as follows:
- 3 S 10-109 LIVE DIGITAL SECURITY SYSTEMS ON PLAYGROUNDS. 1. ANY PLAY-4 GROUND LOCATED IN A CITY WITH A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE SHALL 5 BE EQUIPPED WITH A LIVE DIGITAL SECURITY SYSTEM THAT SENDS LIVE FEED TO 6 THE NEAREST LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.
 - 2. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "LIVE DIGITAL SECURITY SYSTEM" SHALL MEAN A SYSTEM WITH ONE OR MORE CAMERAS THAT PRODUCE LIVE DIGITAL VIDEO OF THE PLAYGROUND SUCH SYSTEM IS LOCATED IN. SUCH SYSTEM SHALL PRODUCE A LIVE VISUAL IMAGE VIEWABLE BY LAW ENFORCEMENT LOCATED AT THE NEAREST LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.
- 3. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE TERM "PLAYGROUND" SHALL MEAN AN AREA DESIGNED, EQUIPPED, AND SET ASIDE FOR PLAY OF SIX OR MORE CHIL-DREN WHICH IS NOT INTENDED FOR USE AS AN ATHLETIC PLAYING FIELD OR ATHLETIC COURT, AND SHALL INCLUDE ANY PLAY EQUIPMENT, SURFACING, FENC-16 ING, SIGNS, INTERNAL PATHWAYS, INTERNAL LAND FORMS, VEGETATION, AND
- 17 RELATED STRUCTURES.
