AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to state appropriations to the state university of New York and the city university of New York

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Clause (iv) of subparagraph 4 of paragraph h of subdivision 2 of section 355 of the education law, as amended by chapter 260 of the laws of 2011, is renumbered clause (v) and a new clause (iv) is added to read as follows:

(IV) THE STATE SHALL APPROPRIATE ANNUALLY AND MAKE AVAILABLE FUND OPERATING SUPPORT INCLUDING FRINGE BENEFITS, FOR THE STATE UNIVER-6 7 SITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT LESS THAN THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED AND MADE AVAIL-UNIVERSITY STATE INSTATE FISCAL YEAR 9 ELEVEN--TWO THOUSAND TWELVE. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 7 of section 6206 of the education law, as amended by chapter 327 of the laws of 2002, is amended by adding a new subparagraph (iv) to read as follows:

- STATE SHALL APPROPRIATE ANNUALLY AND MAKE AVAILABLE STATE 5 SUPPORT FOR OPERATING EXPENSES, INCLUDING FRINGE BENEFITS, FOR THE CITY 6 UNIVERSITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT LESS THAN THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED AND MADE 7 AVAILABLE TO THE CITY UNIVERSITY IN STATE FISCAL YEAR TWO 8 ELEVEN--TWO THOUSAND TWELVE.  - S 5. This act shall take effect immediately provided that:
 - (a) the amendments to subparagraph 4 of paragraph h of subdivision 2 of section 355 of the education law made by section one of shall be subject to the expiration and reversion of such subparagraph pursuant to chapter 260 of the laws of 2011, as amended, when upon such date section two of this act shall take effect; and
- (b) the amendments to paragraph (a) of subdivision 7 of section 6206 of the education law made by section three of this act shall be subject the expiration and reversion of such paragraph pursuant to chapter 260 of the laws of 2011, as amended when upon such date section four of 34 this act shall take effect.
