AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to opioid overdose prevention

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subparagraphs (iii) and (iv) of paragraph (b) of subdivision
2 sion 3 of section 3309 of the public health law, as amended by chapter
3 42 of the laws of 2014, are renumbered subparagraphs (iv) and (v) and a
4 new subparagraph (iii) is added to read as follows:
5 (III) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, RULE OR REGULATION TO THE CONTRA-
6 RY, A SCHOOL NURSE HAVING UNDERTAKEN TRAINING IN AN OPIOID OVERDOSE
7 PREVENTION PROGRAM APPROVED PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION
8 MAY ADMINISTER, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, AN OPIOID ANTAGONIST TO AN
9 OPIOID ANTAGONIST RECIPIENT.
10 S 2. Subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (a) of subdivision 3 of section
11 3309 of the public health law, as amended by chapter 42 of the laws of
12 2014, is renumbered subparagraph (v) and a new subparagraph (iv) is
13 added to read as follows:
14 (IV) "SCHOOL NURSE" MEANS A PERSON LICENSED OR AUTHORIZED TO PRACTICE
15 NURSING PURSUANT TO SECTION SIXTY-NINE HUNDRED FIVE OF THE EDUCATION
16 LAW.
17 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
