AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to the definition of veteran

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph (e) of subdivision 1 of section 458-a of the real property tax law, as amended by chapter 384 of the laws of 2008, is amended to read as follows:

"Veteran" means a person (i) who served in the active military, 5 naval, or air service during a period of war, or who was a recipient of armed forces expeditionary medal, navy expeditionary medal, marine 7 corps expeditionary medal, or global war on terrorism expeditionary and who was discharged or released therefrom under honorable 8 9 conditions, (ii) who was employed by the War Shipping Administration or 10 Office of Defense Transportation or their agents as a merchant seaman documented by the United States Coast Guard or Department of Commerce, 11 12 a civil servant employed by the United States Army Transport 13 Service (later redesignated as the United States Army Transportation 14 Water Division) or the Naval Transportation Service; and who served satisfactorily as a crew member during the period of armed 15 16 conflict, December seventh, nineteen hundred forty-one, to August 17 fifteenth, nineteen hundred forty-five, aboard merchant vessels in oceangoing, i.e., foreign, intercoastal, or coastwise service as such 18 19 terms are defined under federal law (46 USCA 10301 & 10501) and further 20 include "near foreign" voyages between the United States and Canada, Mexico, or the West Indies via ocean routes, or public vessels in ocean-21 going service or foreign waters and who has received a Certificate of 22 23 Release or Discharge from Active Duty and a discharge certificate, or an 24 Honorable Service Certificate/Report of Casualty, from the department of 25 defense, (iii) who served as a United States civilian employed by the

American Field Service and served overseas under United States Armies and United States Army Groups in world war II during the period of armed 3 conflict, December seventh, nineteen hundred forty-one through May eighth, nineteen hundred forty-five, and who was discharged or released 5 therefrom under honorable conditions, (iv) who served as a United States 6 civilian Flight Crew and Aviation Ground Support Employee of Pan Ameri-7 World Airways or one of its subsidiaries or its affiliates and 8 served overseas as a result of Pan American's contract with Air Transport Command or Naval Air Transport Service during the period of armed 9 10 conflict, December fourteenth, nineteen hundred forty-one through August fourteenth, nineteen hundred forty-five, and who was discharged or 11 released therefrom under honorable conditions, [or] (v) notwithstanding 12 13 any other provision of law to the contrary, who are members of the 14 reserve components of the armed forces of the United States who received 15 an honorable discharge or release therefrom under honorable conditions, 16 but are still members of the reserve components of the armed forces of United States provided that such members meet all other qualifica-17 18 tions under the provisions of this section, OR (VI) WHO AS A MEMBER OF 19 RESERVE COMPONENT OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES WERE DEEMED ON ACTIVE DUTY UNDER EXECUTIVE ORDER 11519 SIGNED MARCH TWENTY-THIRD, NINE-20 21 TEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY, 35 FEDERAL REGISTER 5003, DATED TWENTY-FOURTH, NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY AND LATER DESIGNATED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE AS OPERATION GRAPHIC HAND, AND SUCH 23 24 MEMBER WAS DISCHARGED OR RELEASED THEREFROM UNDER HONORABLE CONDITIONS, 25 PROVIDED THAT SUCH MEMBER MEET ALL OTHER QUALIFICATIONS OF THIS SECTION.
