AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to the powers and duties  
of the justice center

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-  
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Section 553 of the executive law is amended by adding a new  
2     subdivision 29 to read as follows:  
3     29. TO DEVELOP GUIDANCE DOCUMENTS RELATING TO THE PROCEDURES FOR  
4     REVIEW OF REPORTABLE INCIDENTS ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION THREE  
5     OF THIS SECTION. ALL SUCH DOCUMENTS SHALL BE ADDRESSED TO EACH STATE  
6     OVERSIGHT AGENCY IDENTIFIED IN SUBDIVISION FOUR OF SECTION FIVE HUNDRED  
7     FIFTY OF THIS ARTICLE AND SHALL CONTAIN A UNIQUE SET OF INSTRUCTIONS FOR  
8     EACH SUCH AGENCY TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION EACH SUCH AGENCY'S PARTICULAR  
9     MISSION AND CONSTITUENCY. EACH SUCH AGENCY SHALL, AT THE REQUEST OF THE  
10    JUSTICE CENTER, PRODUCE FOR THE JUSTICE CENTER'S REVIEW, CURRENT PROCE-  
11    DURES AND PRACTICES UTILIZED IN RECORDING AND REPORTING REPORTABLE INCI-  
12    DENTS. TO ENSURE CONSISTENCY ACROSS STATE AGENCIES, THE JUSTICE CENTER  
13    SHALL DEVELOP OR IDENTIFY A UNIFORM SET OF CORE PRINCIPALS TO BE  
14    INCLUDED IN ANY GUIDANCE DOCUMENTS PRODUCED.  
15    S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall  
16    have become a law.
