AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to the provision of notice to owners whose motor vehicles are subject to safety recalls

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new 2 section 210-a to read as follows:

- MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY RECALL INFORMATION. 1. THE DEPARTMENT 210-A. SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE ITS INTERNET WEBSITE, ON"HTTP://WWW.SAFERCAR.GOV" OPERATED BY THE NATIONAL HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFE-ADMINISTRATION AND PROVIDING ALL MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY RECALLS, BASED ON MOTOR VEHICLE MAKE, MODEL, YEAR AND VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER, BY SUCH ADMINISTRATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE NATIONAL TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY ACT.
- 2. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROMOTE AND PROVIDE PUBLIC NOTICE AVAILABILITY OF INFORMATION ON MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY RECALLS FROM THE DEPARTMENT'S WEBSITE AND THE NATIONAL HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY TRATION AT ITS WEBSITE: "HTTP://WWW.SAFERCAR.GOV". SUCH PROMOTION AND 14 NOTICE SHALL BE PROVIDED ON THE DEPARTMENT'S INTERNET WEBSITE AND ON A INSERT PROVIDED TO MOTOR VEHICLE OWNERS UPON THE ISSUANCE OR 15 SEPARATE RENEWAL OF A REGISTRATION PURSUANT TO ARTICLE FOURTEEN OF THIS CHAPTER. 16
- S 2. Subdivision (a) of section 304 of the vehicle and traffic law, as 17 amended by chapter 608 of the laws of 1993, is amended and a new subdi-18 vision (b-1) is added to read as follows:

(a) No certificate or certificates of inspection shall be issued by an official inspection station until the mechanisms and other equipment, as specified in SUBDIVISION (C) OF section three hundred one [(c)] of this [chapter] ARTICLE, of the motor vehicle inspected are in proper and safe condition and comply with the rules and regulations of the commissioner and with the laws of this state, and the emissions of such motor vehicle conform with subdivision (d) of section three hundred one of this article and regulations promulgated pursuant thereto at the time the certificate is issued.

(B-1)AN OFFICIAL INSPECTION STATION SHALL SUBMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT THE VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER OF EACH VEHICLE SUBJECT TO INSPECTION. THE DEPARTMENT, AFTER REVIEW OF THE NATIONAL HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ADMINISTRATION'S WEBSITE "HTTP://WWW.SAFERCAR.GOV", SHALL PRODUCE AND PROVIDE TO THE OFFICIAL INSPECTION STATION A VEHICLE INSPECTION REPORT INCLUDING A STATEMENT OF ANY MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY RECALLS THAT THE MOTOR IS SUBJECT TO, THAT SUCH RECALLS MAY BE REPAIRED BY A MOTOR VEHICLE DEALER APPROVED BY THE MANUFACTURER OF THE VEHICLE, AND FURTHER INFORMATION ON THE RECALLS MAY BE OBTAINED FROM THE NATIONAL HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY ADMINISTRATION ON ITS WEBSITE: "HTTP://WWW.SAFERCAR.GOV". THE OFFICIAL INSPECTION STATEMENT STATION SHALL DELIVER SUCH PRINTED VEHICLE INSPECTION REPORT TO THE OWNER OF THE INSPECTED MOTOR VEHICLE. IF THE OWNER IS A DEALER, THE DEALER PROVIDE SUCH VEHICLE INSPECTION REPORT TO THE NEXT RETAIL PURCHASER OR LESSEE OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE.

S 3. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeeddate on which it shall have become a law; provided, however, 26 that effective immediately any and all actions necessary to implement 27 provisions of this act on its effective date are authorized and 28 directed to be completed by the department of motor vehicles on or 29 before such effective date. 30
