AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to intentional physical injuries to a police officer

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 120.05 of the penal law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 13 to read as follows:
 - INTENT TO CAUSE PHYSICAL INJURY TO A SPECIFIC POLICE ${ t WITH}$ THEOFFICER, AS POLICE OFFICER IS DEFINED **PURSUANT** TO SUBDIVISION THIRTY-FOUR OF SECTION 1.20 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE LAW, DUE TO A BELIEF OR PERCEPTION REGARDING SUCH POLICE OFFICER'S INVOLVEMENT ARREST OF SUCH PERSON, HE OR SHE CAUSES SUCH INJURY TO SUCH PREVIOUS POLICE OFFICER OR A THIRD PERSON.
- 9 S 2. Subdivision 4 of section 120.10 of the penal law, as amended by 10 chapter 791 of the laws of 1967, is amended and a new subdivision 5 is 11 added to read as follows:
- 4. In the course of and in furtherance of the commission or attempted commission of a felony or of immediate flight therefrom, he, or another participant if there be any, causes serious physical injury to a person other than one of the participants[.]; OR
- 16 INTENT TO CAUSE SERIOUS PHYSICAL INJURY TO A SPECIFIC POLICE WITH17 OFFICER, AS POLICE OFFICER IS DEFINED PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION SECTION 1.20 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE LAW, DUE TO A 18 THIRTY-FOUR OF 19 BELIEF OR PERCEPTION REGARDING SUCH POLICE OFFICER'S INVOLVEMENT SUCH PERSON, HE OR SHE CAUSES SUCH INJURY TO SUCH 20 ARREST OF
- 21 POLICE OFFICER OR TO A THIRD PERSON.
