- AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the establishment of regional secondary schools

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Legislative intent. The legislature hereby finds and declares that given the current fiscal climate in this state, many 2 3 school districts, particularly small districts, are threatened by a 4 decline in educational opportunities and programs for their students. 5 School districts are seeking new models of delivering services to 6 students that are more cost-effective and efficient, in order to sustain 7 or enhance the quality of services and to maintain or expand the scope of services offered to students. The legislature recognizes that many 8 9 in the state are experiencing financial limitations that high schools may impair their ability to offer students the same range or quality of 10 courses that other high schools may provide. In order to ensure that these districts continue to offer their students advanced course work, 11 12 districts should be afforded the opportunity to establish a regional 13 14 secondary school. Under this new model of delivering services, districts 15 will be able to streamline programs and services, increase resources, 16 and increase their purchasing power through shared services. These 17 resultant cost savings will allow money to flow into educational programs and services for students which will, in turn, help to improve 18 student performance and meet college and career readiness. 19

This legislation would establish a pilot program authorizing the establishment of regional secondary schools in any county with a population in excess of one million four hundred thousand inhabitants

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according to the 2010 decennial census, excluding counties located with-1 2 in a city with a population of one million inhabitants or more. This 3 pilot program will help to determine the efficacy of the regional 4 secondary schools in providing greater educational opportunities for less cost. If this pilot program of regional secondary schools is 5 6 successful, the concept could then be expanded statewide.

7 S 2. The education law is amended by adding a new article 39-A to read 8 as follows:

18 1920. ESTABLISHMENT OF A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL OPERATED BY A S 19 BOARD OF EDUCATION. 1. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE 20 CONTRARY, FOR PURPOSES OF THIS ARTICLE, A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL 21 SHALL MEAN A HIGH SCHOOL WITH GRADES SIX, SEVEN AND/OR EIGHT AS AGREED UPON BY EACH OF THE PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS CONSISTENT WITH THE 22 GRADE 23 CONFIGURATION OF THE NEW SECONDARY SCHOOL OR SCHOOLS.

A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL MAY BE ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION BY AGREEMENT OF THE BOARDS OF EDUCATION OF TWO OR MORE CENTRAL 25 26 SCHOOL DISTRICTS, UNION FREE SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND/OR COMMON SCHOOL 27 DISTRICTS THAT ARE WHOLLY CONTAINED WITHIN THE SUPERVISORY DISTRICT OF A BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES, SUBJECT TO THE 28 APPROVAL OF VOTERS OF EACH PARTICIPATING DISTRICT. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT A 29 THE 30 COMPONENT SCHOOL DISTRICT OF A CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT AND A 31 ACT SCHOOL DISTRICT, AS DEFINED IN SECTION FOUR THOUSAND ONE OF SPECIAL 32 THIS CHAPTER, SHALL NOT BE AUTHORIZED TO PARTICIPATE IN A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL. A CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT, SUBJECT TO APPROVAL OF 33 ITS VOTERS, ALSO MAY ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SCHOOL DISTRICTS OTHER 34 35 THAN ITS COMPONENT SCHOOL DISTRICTS THAT ARE WHOLLY CONTAINED WITHIN THE 36 SUPERVISORY DISTRICT OF A BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES TO 37 ESTABLISH A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL. SUCH REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL 38 SERVE ALL OF THE STUDENTS IN EACH OF THE PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS SHALL IN GRADES NINE THROUGH TWELVE AND MAY ALSO SERVE STUDENTS IN GRADES SIX, 39 SEVEN AND/OR EIGHT AS AGREED UPON BY EACH OF THE PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS 40 41 CONSISTENT WITH THE GRADE CONFIGURATION OF THE NEW SECONDARY SCHOOL OR 42 SCHOOLS, PROVIDED THAT EACH PARTICIPATING DISTRICT SHALL CEASE DISTRICT 43 OPERATION OF ITS HIGH SCHOOL, IF THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICT OPER-ATES A HIGH SCHOOL. THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL MAY BE OPERATED BY ONE 44 45 OF THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICTS UPON THE AGREEMENT OF THE OTHER 46 PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS, AND SUCH DISTRICT SHALL ASSUME THE RESPONSIBIL-47 ITY TO OPERATE, SUPERVISE AND MAINTAIN THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL AND ADMINISTRATION OF SUCH SECONDARY SCHOOL. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS ARTI-48 THE 49 CLE, THE SCHOOL DISTRICT DESIGNATED AS THE OPERATING DISTRICT SHALL ΒE 50 REFERRED TO AS THE HOSTING DISTRICT. ALTERNATIVELY, THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL MAY BE OPERATED BY A JOINT BOARD OF EDUCATION ESTAB-51 LISHED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A REGIONAL SECOND-52 53 SCHOOL SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE COMMISSIONER, IN A ARY 54 MANNER AND TIMEFRAME, AS SET FORTH WITHIN THIS SECTION. SCHOOL DISTRICTS 1 PARTICIPATING IN A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL NEED NOT BE GEOGRAPHICALLY 2 CONTIGUOUS.

TO ESTABLISH A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL, TWO OR MORE PARTICIPATING 4 SCHOOL DISTRICTS MUST INITIALLY ADOPT, BY MAJORITY VOTE OF THE BOARD OF 5 EDUCATION OF EACH PARTICIPATING DISTRICT, A RESOLUTION PROPOSING THE 6 ESTABLISHMENT OF SUCH REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL. THE RESOLUTION SHALL 7 INDICATE THE PROPOSED PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND WHETHER THE 8 SCHOOL WOULD BE GOVERNED BY A PROPOSED HOSTING DISTRICT OR A JOINT BOARD 9 EDUCATION AND THE PROPOSED TERM OF THE CONTRACT GOVERNING THE OF 10 REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL. THE RESOLUTION SHALL BE VOTED ON BY EACH 11 BOARD AT A MEETING HELD NO LATER THAN OCTOBER FIRST OF THE SCHOOL YEAR 12 PRIOR TO THE SCHOOL YEAR IN WHICH THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL IS PROPOSED TO COMMENCE OPERATION. IF TWO OR MORE SCHOOL DISTRICTS ADOPT 13 14 SUCH A RESOLUTION, THE RESOLUTION SHALL BE PRESENTED IN A REFERENDUM FOR 15 VOTER APPROVAL IN EACH OF THE PROPOSED PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS. UPON 16 APPROVAL BY THE VOTERS IN EACH OF THE PROPOSED PARTICIPATING SCHOOL 17 DISTRICTS, THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICTS SHALL COLLECTIVELY ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL. IN 18 19 THE EVENT THE VOTERS DO NOT APPROVE SUCH RESOLUTION, THE RESOLUTION MAY 20 BE PRESENTED FOR ONE RE-VOTE IN THE PROPOSED PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS; 21 IF THE BOARDS OF EDUCATION OF ONE OR MORE SUCH DISTRICTS VOTE TO OR, 22 RESCIND THEIR RESOLUTION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL, ONE ADDITIONAL VOTE MAY BE HELD IN EACH OF THE REMAINING 23 24 PROPOSED PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS. IN NO EVENT MAY MORE THAN TWO VOTES BE 25 HELD IN ANY PROPOSED PARTICIPATING DISTRICT IN ANY SCHOOL YEAR.

4. WITH THE CONSENT OF EACH OF THE PARTICIPATING BOARDS OF EDUCATION AND APPROVAL OF THE COMMISSIONER, ADDITIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS OTHERWISE ELIGIBLE TO ESTABLISH THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL MAY JOIN THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL IN THE SECOND OR A SUBSEQUENT YEAR OF OPERA-TION BY ADOPTING A BOARD RESOLUTION AND OBTAINING VOTER APPROVAL SUBSTANTIALLY IN THE MANNER PRESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION TWO OF THIS SECTION.

33 5. (A) UPON RECEIPT OF VOTER APPROVAL IN EACH OF THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICTS, SUCH DISTRICTS SHALL SUBMIT THE PROPOSED CONTRACT, 34 TOGETHER WITH THE PLAN OF FORMATION AND OPERATION OF THE 35 REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL, TO THE COMMISSIONER FOR HIS OR HER APPROVAL, IN A TIME 36 37 AND MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMISSIONER. SUCH CONTRACT SHALL BE AN 38 INTERMUNICIPAL SHARING AGREEMENT PURSUANT TO ARTICLE FIVE-G OF THE 39 GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW THAT COMPLIES WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS 40 SECTION.

41 (B) THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL AND THE PROPOSED CONTRACT SHALL MEET 42 THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

43 (I) THE CONTRACT SHALL SPECIFY ITS TERM, WHICH SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN 44 FIVE NOR MORE THAN SEVEN SCHOOL YEARS, AND SHALL EITHER DESIGNATE THE 45 BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE HOSTING DISTRICT AS THE GOVERNING BOARD THAT WILL OPERATE THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL ON BEHALF OF ALL PARTICIPAT-46 47 ING DISTRICTS, OR THE JOINT BOARD OF EDUCATION THAT WILL SERVE AS 48 GOVERNING BOARD FOR THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL. THE GOVERNING BOARD 49 SHALL HAVE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE OPERATION, SUPERVISION AND MAINTENANCE 50 OF THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL AND SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ADMIN-51 ISTRATION OF THE SCHOOL, INCLUDING THE CURRICULUM, GRADING, STAFFING AND THE ISSUANCE OF DIPLOMAS FOR ALL STUDENTS THAT ATTEND THE REGIONAL 52 SECONDARY SCHOOL, AS SHALL BE DESIGNATED IN THE CONTRACT. PROVIDED, 53 54 HOWEVER, THAT THE CONTRACT MAY PROVIDE FOR ISSUANCE OF THE DIPLOMA BY 55 STUDENT'S SCHOOL DISTRICT OF RESIDENCE UPON CERTIFICATION BY THE THE GOVERNING BOARD THAT ALL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS OF THE REGIONAL SECOND-56

1 ARY SCHOOL HAVE BEEN MET. THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL SHALL BE DEEMED 2 A SCHOOL OF THE GOVERNING BOARD FOR ACCOUNTABILITY PURPOSES;

(II) THE CONTRACT SHALL PROVIDE THE NAME OF THE SCHOOL, WHICH SHALL BE
SUBJECT TO THE COMMISSIONER'S APPROVAL, THE GRADES OF INSTRUCTION
INTENDED TO BE SERVED BY THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL, AND DESIGNATE
THE SITE OF THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL, WHICH SHALL BE WITHIN THE
BOUNDARIES OF ONE OF THE PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS AND WHERE POSSIBLE,
SHOULD USE EXISTING BUILDINGS AND/OR INFRASTRUCTURE;

9 (III) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, THE 10 CONTRACT SHALL PROVIDE THAT EACH PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING OR ARRANGING FOR TRANSPORTATION TO ITS RESI-11 DENT STUDENTS ATTENDING THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL IN ACCORDANCE WITH 12 ITS SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICY, BUT WITHOUT REGARD TO ANY MAXIMUM MILEAGE 13 14 LIMITATION. SUCH TRANSPORTATION MAY BE PROVIDED BY CONTRACT, INCLUDING 15 BUT NOT LIMITED TO A CONTRACT WITH ONE OR MORE PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS OR A BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES; 16

17 (IV) THE CONTRACT SHALL SPECIFY THAT THE STUDENTS OF EACH PARTICIPAT-18 ING SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL REMAIN ENROLLED AS STUDENTS OF THEIR RESPEC-19 TIVE PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICTS, AND THEY SHALL BE TREATED AND 20 COUNTED AS SUCH FOR PURPOSES OF ALL STATE AID CALCULATIONS PURSUANT TO 21 THIS CHAPTER;

22 THE CONTRACT SHALL EITHER DESIGNATE THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE (V) HOSTING DISTRICT TO SERVE AS THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE REGIONAL SECOND-23 ARY SCHOOL OR SHALL PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NEW JOINT BOARD 24 25 EDUCATION FOR THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL WITH AT LEAST FIVE OF 26 MEMBERS, WITH REPRESENTATIVES APPOINTED BY EACH PARTICIPATING DISTRICT. 27 THE CONTRACT SHALL SPECIFY THE NUMBER, TERM, AND PROCEDURES FOR APPOINT-MENT OF JOINT BOARD MEMBERS. 34 (VI) THE CONTRACT SHALL SPECIFY THE CURRENT ENROLLMENT OF ALL PARTIC-35 IPATING SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND THE PROJECTED TOTAL ENROLLMENT NUMBERS OF 36 THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL;

37 (VII) THE CONTRACT MUST DEMONSTRATE HOW THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL 38 WILL PROVIDE INCREASED EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES, INCLUDING COURSES AND 39 PROGRAMS IN SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING AND MATH, TO PREPARE 40 STUDENTS FOR COLLEGE AND CAREER READINESS AND IMPROVE STUDENT PERFORM-41 ANCE;

(VIII) ALL TEACHERS, TEACHING ASSISTANTS AND TEACHER AIDES OF 42 THE 43 PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICTS, WHOSE SERVICES IN THE PARTICIPATING 44 SCHOOL DISTRICTS ARE NO LONGER NEEDED BECAUSE OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A 45 REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL OR THE TRANSFER OF STUDENTS TO AN EXISTING REIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL, AS A RESULT OF A NEW PARTICIPATING SCHOOL 46 47 DISTRICT JOINING THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL SHALL IMMEDIATELY BECOME 48 EMPLOYEES OF THE GOVERNING BOARD DESIGNATED IN THE CONTRACT, AND SHALL 49 RETAIN THEIR TENURE AND/OR EMPLOYMENT STATUS AND THE SENIORITY GAINED IN 50 THE PARTICIPATING DISTRICT. IF THE NUMBER OF TEACHING, TEACHING ASSIST-ANT OR TEACHER AIDE POSITIONS NEEDED TO PROVIDE THE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES 51 REQUIRED BY A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL IS LESS THAN THE NUMBER OF 52 TEACHERS, TEACHING ASSISTANTS, AND TEACHER AIDES ELIGIBLE TO BE CONSID-53 54 ERED EMPLOYEES OF THE DESIGNATED GOVERNING BOARD OF SUCH REGIONAL 55 SECONDARY SCHOOL PURSUANT TO THIS PARAGRAPH, THE SERVICES OF THE TEACH-ERS, TEACHING ASSISTANTS AND TEACHER AIDES HAVING THE LEAST SENIORITY IN 56

THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICT WITHIN THE TENURE AREA OR CIVIL 1 SERVICE STATUS, AS THE CASE MAY BE, OF THE POSITION SHALL BE DISCONTIN-2 3 UED. ANY SUCH EMPLOYEES WHO ARE TEACHERS, TEACHING ASSISTANTS OR TEACHER 4 AIDES SHALL BE PLACED ON A PREFERRED ELIGIBLE LIST OF CANDIDATES FOR 5 APPOINTMENT TO A VACANCY THAT MAY THEREAFTER OCCUR IN AN OFFICE OR POSIб TION UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICT IN 7 ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION TWENTY-FIVE HUNDRED TEN OR 8 THREE THOUSAND THIRTEEN OF THIS CHAPTER. FOR ANY SUCH TEACHER, TEACHING ASSISTANT OR TEACHER AIDE WHO IS RETAINED BY THE GOVERNING BOARD, FOR 9 10 SALARY, SICK LEAVE AND ANY OTHER PURPOSES, THE LENGTH OF SERVICE CREDIT-ED IN SUCH PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICT PRIOR TO ITS PARTICIPATION IN 11 REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL SHALL BE CREDITED AS EMPLOYMENT TIME WITH 12 THE 13 THE DESIGNATED GOVERNING BOARD;

14 (IX) UPON TERMINATION OF THE CONTRACT PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION AND THE 15 RETURN OF STUDENTS FROM THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL TO THE FORMER PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICT, THE TEACHERS, TEACHING ASSISTANTS, AND 16 17 TEACHER AIDES EMPLOYED BY THE GOVERNING BOARD TO SERVE IN THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL SHALL HAVE THE SAME EMPLOYMENT RIGHTS IN THE PARTIC-18 19 IPATING SCHOOL DISTRICTS AS TEACHERS WOULD HAVE UPON TAKEOVER OF A BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES PROGRAM BY SUCH SCHOOL DISTRICTS 20 21 PURSUANT TO SECTION THREE THOUSAND FOURTEEN-B OF THIS CHAPTER;

(X) THE CONTRACT SHALL SPECIFY THE PROCESS FOR DEVELOPMENT OF THE
BUDGET FOR THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL BY THE DESIGNATED GOVERNING
BOARD AND HOW OPERATING AND ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS AND THE LOCAL SHARE OF
CAPITAL EXPENSES ATTRIBUTABLE TO THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL WILL BE
ALLOCATED AMONG THE PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS;

27 (XI) THE CONTRACT SHALL SPECIFY THE COSTS OF THE REGIONAL SECONDARY
28 SCHOOL, STAFFING, CURRENT AND FUTURE CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION PLANS AND FOR
29 THE DELIVERY OF SPECIAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS;

(XII) THE CONTRACT SHALL SPECIFY THE PROCEDURES FOR DISCIPLINE OF
 STUDENTS ATTENDING THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL, INCLUDING THE APPLICA BLE CODE OF CONDUCT PROVIDED THAT SUCH CODE OF CONDUCT MEETS THE
 REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION TWENTY-EIGHT HUNDRED ONE OF THIS TITLE AND
 PROCEDURES FOR SUPERINTENDENTS' HEARINGS AND APPEALS TO THE BOARD OF
 EDUCATION PURSUANT TO SECTION THIRTY-TWO HUNDRED FOURTEEN OF THIS CHAP TER;

47 (XVI) THE CONTRACT SHALL SPECIFY WHETHER THE EMPLOYEES OF THE REGIONAL
48 SECONDARY SCHOOL SHALL ESTABLISH NEW EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATIONS, PURSUANT TO

50 WHERE APPLICABLE, WHETHER THEY SHALL BECOME MEMBERS OF THE APPLICABLE
51 EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATIONS REPRESENTING THE EMPLOYEES OF THE HOSTING
52 DISTRICT; AND

53 (XVII) THE CONTRACT SHALL SET FORTH ANY OTHER INFORMATION OR ANALYSIS 54 AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSIONER.

55 6. IF THE COMMISSIONER APPROVES THE PROPOSED CONTRACT, THE REGIONAL 56 SECONDARY SCHOOL SHALL BE ESTABLISHED. THE CONTRACT SHALL BE FOR A PERI- 1 OD OF AT LEAST FIVE AND NOT MORE THAN SEVEN SCHOOL YEARS AND, WITH THE 2 APPROVAL OF THE COMMISSIONER, MAY BE RENEWED BY MUTUAL AGREEMENT OF THE 3 BOARDS OF EDUCATION OF THE PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS. THE REGIONAL SECOND-4 ARY SCHOOL SHALL COMMENCE OPERATIONS ON THE FIRST OF JULY, AND SHALL NOT 5 CEASE OPERATIONS BEFORE THE THIRTIETH OF JUNE IN ANY SCHOOL YEAR.

6 S 1921. ESTABLISHMENT OF A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL OPERATED BY A 7 BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES. 1. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER 8 PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, FOR PURPOSES OF THIS ARTICLE, A 9 REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL SHALL MEAN A HIGH SCHOOL WITH GRADES SIX, 10 SEVEN AND/OR EIGHT AS AGREED UPON BY EACH OF THE PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS 11 CONSISTENT WITH THE GRADE CONFIGURATION OF THE NEW SECONDARY SCHOOL OR 12 SCHOOLS.

13 2. A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL MAY BE ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO THIS 14 SECTION BY AGREEMENT OF A BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES AND 15 THE BOARDS OF EDUCATION OF TWO OR MORE CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS, UNION FREE SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND/OR COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICTS THAT ARE WHOLLY 16 CONTAINED WITHIN THE SUPERVISORY DISTRICT OF THE BOARD OF COOPERATIVE 17 EDUCATIONAL SERVICES, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE VOTERS OF THE 18 19 PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT A COMPONENT SCHOOL DISTRICT OF A CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT AND A SPECIAL ACT SCHOOL 20 21 DISTRICT, AS DEFINED IN SECTION FOUR THOUSAND ONE OF THIS CHAPTER, SHALL NOT BE AUTHORIZED TO PARTICIPATE IN A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL. A 22 CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT, SUBJECT TO APPROVAL OF ITS VOTERS, ALSO 23 MAY ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL 24 25 SERVICES AND SCHOOL DISTRICTS OTHER THAN ITS COMPONENT SCHOOL DISTRICTS THAT ARE WHOLLY CONTAINED WITHIN THE SUPERVISORY DISTRICT OF THE BOARD 26 COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES TO ESTABLISH A REGIONAL SECONDARY 27 OF SCHOOL. SUCH REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL SHALL SERVE ALL OF THE 28 STUDENTS IN EACH OF THE PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS IN GRADES NINE THROUGH TWELVE AND 29 MAY ALSO SERVE STUDENTS IN GRADES SIX, SEVEN AND/OR EIGHT AS AGREED UPON 30 BY EACH OF THE PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS CONSISTENT WITH THE GRADE CONFIG-31 32 URATION OF THE NEW SECONDARY SCHOOL OR SCHOOLS, PROVIDED THAT EACH PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL CEASE DISTRICT OPERATION OF ITS HIGH 33 34 SCHOOL, IF SAID PARTICIPATING DISTRICT OPERATES A HIGH SCHOOL. THE 35 REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL SHALL BE OPERATED BY THE BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES, WHICH SHALL ASSUME THE RESPONSIBILITY TO OPERATE, 36 37 SUPERVISE AND MAINTAIN THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL AND THE ADMINIS-38 TRATION OF SUCH SECONDARY SCHOOL. THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE COMMISSIONER, 39 40 IN A MANNER AND TIMEFRAME, AS SET FORTH WITHIN THIS SECTION. SCHOOL DISTRICTS PARTICIPATING IN A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL NEED NOT BE 41 42 GEOGRAPHICALLY CONTIGUOUS.

43 3. TO ESTABLISH A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL, TWO OR MORE PARTICIPATING 44 SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND THE BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES MUST 45 INITIALLY ADOPT, BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF EACH PARTICIPATING DISTRICT AND THE BOARD OF 46 COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL 47 SERVICES, A RESOLUTION PROPOSING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SUCH REGIONAL 48 SECONDARY SCHOOL. THE RESOLUTION SHALL INDICATE THAT THE BOARD OF COOP-49 ERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES WILL OPERATE THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL 50 ON BEHALF OF THE PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS AND SPECIFY THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND THE PROPOSED TERM OF THE CONTRACT GOVERNING THE 51 REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL. THE RESOLUTION SHALL BE VOTED ON BY EACH 52 BOARD AT A MEETING HELD NO LATER THAN OCTOBER FIRST OF THE SCHOOL YEAR 53 54 PRIOR TO THE SCHOOL YEAR IN WHICH THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL IS 55 PROPOSED TO COMMENCE OPERATION. IF TWO OR MORE SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND THE 56 BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES ADOPT SUCH A RESOLUTION, THE

RESOLUTION MUST THEN BE PRESENTED IN A REFERENDUM FOR VOTER APPROVAL IN 1 EACH OF THE PROPOSED PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS. UPON APPROVAL BY THE 2 3 IN EACH OF THE PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS, THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOL VOTERS 4 DISTRICTS AND THE BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES SHALL 5 COLLECTIVELY ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A REGIONAL 6 SECONDARY SCHOOL. IN THE EVENT THE VOTERS DO NOT APPROVE SUCH RESOL-7 UTION, THE RESOLUTION MAY BE PRESENTED FOR ONE RE-VOTE; OR, IF THE 8 BOARDS OF EDUCATION OF ONE OR MORE SUCH DISTRICTS VOTE TO RESCIND THEIR RESOLUTION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL, ONE ADDI-9 10 TIONAL VOTE MAY BE HELD IN EACH OF THE REMAINING PROPOSED PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS. IN NO EVENT MAY MORE THAN TWO VOTES BE HELD IN ANY PROPOSED 11 PARTICIPATING DISTRICT IN ANY SCHOOL YEAR. 12

4. WITH THE CONSENT OF EACH OF THE PARTICIPATING BOARDS OF EDUCATION AND THE BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES AND APPROVAL OF THE COMMISSIONER, ADDITIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS OTHERWISE ELIGIBLE TO ESTAB-LISH THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL MAY JOIN THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL IN THE SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT YEAR OF OPERATION BY ADOPTING A BOARD RESOLUTION AND OBTAINING VOTER APPROVAL SUBSTANTIALLY IN THE MANNER PRESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION TWO OF THIS SECTION.

5. (A) UPON RECEIPT OF VOTER APPROVAL, THE PROPOSED CONTRACT, TOGETHER WITH THE PLAN OF FORMATION AND OPERATION OF THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL, SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE COMMISSIONER FOR HIS OR HER APPROVAL, IN A TIME AND MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMISSIONER. SUCH CONTRACT SHALL BE AN INTER-MUNICIPAL SHARING AGREEMENT PURSUANT TO ARTICLE FIVE-G OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW THAT COMPLIES WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

(B) THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL AND THE PROPOSED CONTRACT SHALL MEETTHE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

(I) THE CONTRACT SHALL SPECIFY ITS TERM, WHICH SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN 29 FIVE NOR MORE THAN SEVEN SCHOOL YEARS, AND SHALL PROVIDE THAT THE BOARD 30 OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES WILL OPERATE THE REGIONAL SECONDARY 31 32 SCHOOL ON BEHALF OF ALL PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS. THE BOARD OF COOPER-ATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES SHALL SERVE AS THE GOVERNING BODY FOR 33 THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL AND SHALL HAVE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE OPERA-34 35 TION, SUPERVISION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL AND SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF SUCH SCHOOL, INCLUDING 36 37 GRADING AND THE ISSUANCE OF DIPLOMAS FOR ALL STUDENTS THAT ATTEND THE 38 REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL, AS SHALL BE DESIGNATED IN THE CONTRACT. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT THE CONTRACT MAY PROVIDE FOR ISSUANCE OF THE 39 40 DIPLOMA BY THE STUDENT'S SCHOOL DISTRICT OF RESIDENCE UPON CERTIFICATION THE GOVERNING BOARD THAT ALL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS OF THE REGIONAL 41 BY SECONDARY SCHOOL HAVE BEEN MET. THE BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL 42 43 SERVICES SHALL ALSO ACT AS A SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR ACCOUNTABILITY 44 PURPOSES;

(II) THE CONTRACT SHALL PROVIDE THE NAME OF THE SCHOOL, WHICH SHALL BE
SUBJECT TO THE COMMISSIONER'S APPROVAL, THE GRADES OF INSTRUCTION
INTENDED TO BE SERVED BY THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL, AND DESIGNATE
THE SITE OF THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL, WHICH SHALL BE WITHIN THE
BOUNDARIES OF THE SUPERVISORY DISTRICT OF THE BOARD OF COOPERATIVE
EDUCATIONAL SERVICES AND WHERE POSSIBLE, SHOULD USE EXISTING BUILDINGS
AND/OR INFRASTRUCTURE;

(III) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE CONTRACT SHALL
PROVIDE THAT EACH PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR
PROVIDING OR ARRANGING FOR TRANSPORTATION TO ITS RESIDENT STUDENTS
ATTENDING THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL IN ACCORDANCE WITH ITS SCHOOL
DISTRICT POLICY, BUT WITHOUT REGARD TO ANY MAXIMUM MILEAGE LIMITATION.

1 SUCH TRANSPORTATION MAY BE PROVIDED BY CONTRACT, INCLUDING BUT NOT 2 LIMITED TO A CONTRACT WITH ONE OR MORE PARTICIPATING DISTRICTS OR A 3 BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES;

4 (IV) THE CONTRACT SHALL SPECIFY THAT THE STUDENTS OF EACH PARTICIPAT-5 ING SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL REMAIN ENROLLED AS STUDENTS OF THEIR RESPEC-6 TIVE PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICTS, AND THEY SHALL BE TREATED AND 7 COUNTED AS SUCH FOR PURPOSES OF ALL STATE AID CALCULATIONS PURSUANT TO 8 THIS CHAPTER;

9 (V) THE CONTRACT SHALL SPECIFY THE CURRENT ENROLLMENT OF ALL PARTIC-10 IPATING SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND THE PROJECTED TOTAL ENROLLMENT NUMBERS OF 11 THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL;

12 (VI) THE CONTRACT MUST DEMONSTRATE HOW THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL 13 WILL PROVIDE INCREASED EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES, INCLUDING COURSES AND 14 PROGRAMS IN SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING AND MATH, TO PREPARE 15 STUDENTS FOR COLLEGE AND CAREER READINESS AND IMPROVE STUDENT PERFORM-16 ANCE;

(VII) ALL TEACHERS, TEACHING ASSISTANTS AND TEACHER AIDES OF THE 17 PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICTS, WHOSE SERVICES IN THE PARTICIPATING 18 19 SCHOOL DISTRICTS ARE NO LONGER NEEDED BECAUSE OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL OR THE TRANSFER OF STUDENTS TO AN EXISTING 20 21 REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL AS A RESULT OF A NEW PARTICIPATING SCHOOL 22 DISTRICT JOINING THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL, SHALL BECOME EMPLOYEES 23 OF THE BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES, AND SHALL RETAIN THEIR 24 TENURE AND/OR EMPLOYMENT STATUS AND THE SENIORITY GAINED IN THE PARTIC-25 IPATING DISTRICT. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, THE 45 SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT OWNS THE FACILITY USED TO HOUSE THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL SHALL BE THE ONLY SCHOOL DISTRICT ELIGIBLE FOR BUILDING 46 47 PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF SUBDIVISION SIX, SIX-A, AID 48 SIX-C, SIX-E OR SIX-F OF SECTION THIRTY-SIX HUNDRED TWO OF THIS CHAPTER INVOLVING THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL THAT ARE APPROVED 49 FOR PROJECTS 50 BY THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SUCH DISTRICT AFTER ESTABLISHMENT OF THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL, PROVIDED THAT SUCH AID SHALL BE COMPUTED 51 USING THE BUILDING AID RATIO APPLICABLE TO PROJECTS OF THE 52 SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT OWNS THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL FACILITY UNDER THE 53 54 PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPHS B AND C OF SUBDIVISION SIX OF SECTION 55 THIRTY-SIX HUNDRED TWO OF THIS CHAPTER. SUCH AID SHALL BE PAID TO SUCH 56 SCHOOL DISTRICT OR TO THE BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES ON

SUCH SCHOOL DISTRICT WHERE THE BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCA-BEHALF OF 1 TIONAL SERVICES OPERATES THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL. THE 2 SCHOOL 3 DISTRICT OR BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES SHALL ALLOCATE THE 4 LOCAL SHARE OF THE COSTS OF SUCH PROJECTS TO THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOL 5 DISTRICTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ITS CONTRACT ENTERED INTO PURSUANT ΤO 6 SECTION NINETEEN HUNDRED TWENTY OR NINETEEN HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE OF THIS 7 ARTICLE. THE COSTS OF SUCH PROJECTS SHALL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR AID PURSU-8 ANT TO SUBDIVISION SIX-B OR PARAGRAPH C OF SUBDIVISION FOURTEEN OF 9 SECTION THIRTY-SIX HUNDRED TWO OF THIS CHAPTER.

10 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF SECTION NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY OR 3. NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE OF THIS TITLE TO THE CONTRARY, IN THE CASE OF 11 A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL OPERATED BY A BOARD OF COOPERATIVE 12 EDUCA-TIONAL SERVICES THAT IS HOUSED IN A FACILITY OWNED BY A PARTICIPATING 13 14 SCHOOL DISTRICT, THE CAPITAL EXPENSES FOR BUILDING PROJECTS INVOLVING 15 THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL SHALL BE A CHARGE UPON THE PARTICIPATING 16 SCHOOL DISTRICTS ONLY, AND SUCH COSTS SHALL NOT BE ALLOCATED TO OTHER COMPONENT SCHOOL DISTRICTS. SUCH CAPITAL EXPENSES SHALL NOT BE ELIGIBLE 17 FOR AID PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION FIVE OF SECTION NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY 18 19 OF THIS TITLE. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT COSTS OF AIDABLE SHARED SERVICES 20 PROVIDED BY THE BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES TO SUPPLEMENT 21 THE PROGRAMS OF THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR AID PURSUANT TO SUCH SUBDIVISION FIVE OF SECTION NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY, THE 22 ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES ATTRIBUTABLE TO THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL 23 THE CAPITAL EXPENSES ATTRIBUTABLE TO A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL 24 AND 25 HOUSED IN A FACILITY OWNED BY THE BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SHALL BE ALLOCATED TO COMPONENT SCHOOL DISTRICTS IN ACCORDANCE 26 SERVICES 27 WITH SECTION NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY OR NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE OF AND SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR AID PURSUANT TO SUCH SUBDIVISION 28 THIS TITLE 29 FIVE OF SECTION NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY.

30 4. THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF EACH SCHOOL DISTRICT PARTICIPATING IN A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR 31 32 ADDITIONAL STATE AID PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION FOURTEEN OF SECTION THIR-33 TY-SIX HUNDRED TWO OF THIS CHAPTER IN THE SAME MANNER AND TO THE SAME EXTENT AS A SCHOOL DISTRICT WHICH QUALIFIES FOR SUCH AID PURSUANT TO 34 35 PARAGRAPH J OF SUBDIVISION FOURTEEN OF SECTION THIRTY-SIX HUNDRED TWO OF THIS CHAPTER; PROVIDED FURTHER THAT SUCH DISTRICT SHALL BE ELIGIBLE то 36 RECEIVE AN ADDITIONAL APPORTIONMENT EQUAL TO TWENTY-FIVE PERCENT OF SUCH 37 38 APPORTIONMENT COMPUTED PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION FOURTEEN OF SECTION THIR-39 TY-SIX HUNDRED TWO OF THIS CHAPTER UPON MEETING ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT 40 GOALS AS ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSIONER IN ACCORDANCE WITH A METHODOL-PRESCRIBED IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSIONER. IN NO CASE SHALL 41 OGY THE SUM OF SUCH APPORTIONMENTS UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH PLUS THE SELECTED 42 43 OPERATING AID PER PUPIL BE MORE THAN A TOTAL OF NINETY-FIVE PER CENTUM 44 OF THE YEAR PRIOR TO THE BASE YEAR APPROVED OPERATING EXPENSE.

45 S 1923. REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL ADVISORY COMMITTEE. 1. EACH REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL ESTABLISHED AND OPERATED PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE SHALL 46 47 ESTABLISH AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE. THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE SHALL BE 48 COMPOSED OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF EACH PARTICIPAT-49 ING SCHOOL DISTRICT, THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF EACH SUPERVISORY BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES, WHERE APPLICABLE, 50 THE SUPERINTENDENT OF EACH PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE 51 AND SUPERINTENDENT OF THE SUPERVISORY DISTRICT IN WHICH THE REGIONAL SECOND-52 53 ARY SCHOOL IS LOCATED. THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE SUPERVISORY DISTRICT 54 SHALL BE THE CHAIR OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

55 2. THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE SHALL CONVENE, AT THE CALL OF THE CHAIR, NOT 56 LESS THAN FOUR TIMES DURING EACH SCHOOL YEAR DURING WHICH THE REGIONAL 1 SECONDARY SCHOOL OPERATES. DURING SUCH MEETINGS, THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE 2 SHALL REVIEW THE OPERATION OF THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL AND MAKE 3 RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE HOSTING DISTRICT OR THE SUPERVISORY BOARD OF 4 COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES, AS THE CASE MAY BE, ON THE CONTINUED 5 OPERATION OF SUCH SECONDARY SCHOOL.

6 S 1924. APPLICABILITY. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL ONLY BE 7 APPLICABLE IN COUNTIES WITH A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED 8 THOUSAND INHABITANTS OR MORE ACCORDING TO THE 2010 DECENNIAL CENSUS, 9 EXCLUDING COUNTIES LOCATED WITHIN A CITY WITH A POPULATION OF ONE 10 MILLION INHABITANTS OR MORE.

PURSUANT TO ARTICLE THIRTY-NINE-A OF THIS TITLE, A BOARD OF COOP-14 ERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES MAY ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH TWO OR 15 MORE SCHOOL DISTRICTS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER SUCH AN AGREEMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION NINETEEN HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE OF THIS TITLE, WHICH MAY INCLUDE CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS, CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICTS, UNION 16 17 18 FREE SCHOOL DISTRICTS, AND/OR COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICTS WHICH ARE WHOLLY 19 CONTAINED WITHIN THE SUPERVISORY DISTRICT OF THE BOARD OF COOPERATIVE 20 EDUCATIONAL SERVICES, TO FORM A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL TO BE OPERATED 21 BY THE BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES. THE BOARD OF COOPER-EDUCATIONAL SERVICES SHALL HAVE THE SAME POWERS AND DUTIES WITH 22 ATIVE RESPECT TO SUCH REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL AS THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF A 23 24 UNION FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT HAS WITH RESECT TO ITS SCHOOLS, CONSISTENT 25 WITH THE TERMS OF ITS AGREEMENT WITH THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICTS. 26 S 4. Paragraph h of subdivision 4 of section 1950 of the education law 27 amended by adding three new subparagraphs 12, 13 and 14 to read as is 28 follows:

29 (12) TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS AS NECESSARY OR CONVENIENT TO OPERATE A 30 REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL AS ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF 31 SECTION NINETEEN HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE OF THIS TITLE.

(13) TO DEVELOP CORE CURRICULUM FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING A REGIONAL
 SECONDARY SCHOOL ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION NINE TEEN HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE OF THIS TITLE.

(14) TO ISSUE REGENTS AND OTHER HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMAS TO STUDENTS WHO
 GRADUATE FROM A REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO THE
 PROVISIONS OF SECTION NINETEEN HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE OF THIS TITLE, UNDER
 THE SAME CONDITIONS AS A SCHOOL DISTRICT.

39 S 5. Paragraph b of subdivision 4 of section 1950 of the education law 40 is amended by adding a new subparagraph 8 to read as follows:

(8) FOR REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOLS ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO SECTION 41 NINETEEN HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE OF THIS TITLE, THE BOARD OF COOPERATIVE 42 43 EDUCATIONAL SERVICES SHALL PREPARE AND PROPOSE A TENTATIVE BUDGET OF 44 EXPENDITURES FOR PROGRAM, ADMINISTRATIVE AND CAPITAL COSTS TO OPERATE 45 THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL IN THE ENSUING SCHOOL YEAR. SUCH PROPOSED BUDGET SHALL BE PROVIDED TO THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF EACH PARTICIPATING 46 47 SCHOOL DISTRICT OF THE REGIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL, BY THE DATE PROVIDED 48 IN THE AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO PURSUANT TO SUCH SECTION NINETEEN HUNDRED 49 TWENTY-ONE. THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF EACH PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICT 50 SHALL BE AFFORDED AN OPPORTUNITY TO REVIEW AND COMMENT ON THE PROPOSED BUDGET PRIOR TO ITS FINAL ADOPTION BY THE BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCA-51 52 TIONAL SERVICES.

53 S 6. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015, provided that if this 54 act becomes a law after such date, it shall take effect immediately and 55 be deemed to have been in full force and effect on and after July 1, 56 2015.
