AN ACT to amend the banking law, in relation to requiring banks and financial institutions entering into negotiations to modify a mortgage on real property located in this state to be responsible for the continuation of the modification process until its completion regardless of whether the mortgage is sold

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The banking law is amended by adding a new section 6-n to read as follows:

- S 6-N. RESPONSIBILITY OF BANKS FOR MORTGAGES BEING PROCESSED FOR MODIFICATION. 1. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISIONS OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, ANY BANK OR FINANCIAL INSTITUTION ENTERING INTO NEGOTIATIONS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO PROCESSING AN APPLICATION, TO MODIFY A MORTGAGE ON REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN THIS STATE SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE MODIFICATION PROCESS UNTIL ITS COMPLETION REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE MORTGAGE IS SOLD, TRANSFERRED OR BUNDLED INTO A SECURITY PACKAGE FOR PROVISION TO A THIRD PARTY DURING THE MODIFICATION PROCESS.
- 2. IF A MORTGAGE THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF NEGOTIATIONS OR APPLICATION 11 FOR A MODIFICATION OF THE MORTGAGE TERMS IS SOLD, TRANSFERRED OR BUNDLED 12 SECURITY PACKAGE FOR PROVISION TO A THIRD PARTY DURING THE 13 MODIFICATION PROCESS, SUCH MORTGAGE SHALL BE AUTOMATICALLY DEEMED HAVE BEEN MODIFIED AS SPECIFIED IN THE MORTGAGE MODIFICATION APPLICATION 15 16 AND THEPURCHASER OF SUCH MORTGAGE MUST ACCEPT ANY DECISION RENDERED WITH REGARD TO SUCH MODIFICATION AND BE 17 BOUND BY THETERMS MODIFICATION AGREEMENT, INCLUDING THE INTEREST RATE IN EFFECT AT THE 18 TIME OF PROCESSING. THE PURCHASER SHALL ASSUME ALL RIGHTS AND RESPONSI-19 20 BILITIES NECESSARY TO COMPLY WITH THE MODIFIED LOAN.
- 3. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY TO ANY MORTGAGE LOAN WHICH IS THREE MONTHS OR OLDER AT THE TIME OF THE MODIFICATION PROCESS.
- 23 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 24 have become a law.
