AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to the qualifications for holding the office of assistant district attorney in the county of Wyoming

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 3 of the public officers law is amended by adding a new subdivision 64 to read as follows:
- 64. IN THE COUNTY OF WYOMING, THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION REQUIRING
- A PERSON TO BE A RESIDENT OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE FOR WHICH HE OR SHE SHALL BE CHOSEN OR WITHIN
- WHICH HIS OR HER OFFICIAL FUNCTIONS ARE REQUIRED TO BE EXERCISED,
- 7 PREVENT A PERSON FROM HOLDING THE OFFICE OF ASSISTANT DISTRICT 8 ATTORNEY OF THE COUNTY OF WYOMING, PROVIDED THAT SUCH PERSON RESIDES
- WYOMING COUNTY OR AN ADJOINING COUNTY WITHIN THE STATE OF NEW YORK; 9
- PROVIDED, HOWEVER THAT ANY PERSON PERFORMING SUCH FUNCTIONS OR HOLDING 10
- THE OFFICE OF ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY IN ANY OTHER COUNTY SHALL BE A 11
- RESIDENT OF SUCH COUNTY UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW. THE PROVISIONS 12
- THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL NOT APPLY TO ANY PERSON HOLDING THE OFFICE OF 13
- FIRST ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY OR CHIEF ASSISTANT DISTRICT 14 WHICH WOULD ASSUME THE DUTIES OF THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY 15 THE HOLDER OF
- 16 UPON THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S ABSENCE FROM THE COUNTY OR UPON
- 17 DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S INABILITY TO PERFORM HIS OR HER DUTIES.
- 18 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
