- AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to requiring physicians and hospitals to obtain the name of the school attended by school-aged patients and to include this information in their admission registration forms

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 2 230-e to read as follows:

3 S 230-E. REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS. EVERY PHYSICIAN SHALL INQUIRE AND 4 DOCUMENT AS PART OF HIS OR HER PATIENT REGISTRATION, THE NAME AND 5 ADDRESS OF THE SCHOOL ATTENDED BY SUCH PHYSICIAN'S SCHOOL-AGED PATIENTS 6 AND INCLUDE SUCH INFORMATION IN THE PATIENTS' MEDICAL REGISTRATION FORM. 7 S 2. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 2805-y 8 to read as follows:

9 S 2805-Y. ADMISSION REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS. ALL GENERAL HOSPITALS 10 SHALL INQUIRE AND DOCUMENT THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE SCHOOL ATTENDED 11 BY SCHOOL-AGED PATIENTS UPON ADMISSION, AND INCLUDE SUCH INFORMATION ON 12 THE HOSPITALS' ADMISSION REGISTRATION FORM.

13 S 3. This act shall take effect one year after the date upon which it 14 shall have become a law.
