AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to authorizing hunting in the county of Seneca; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon the expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Item (i) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of the environmental conservation law, as amended by section 14 of part 3 EE of chapter 55 of the laws of 2014, is amended to read as follows:
