AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to the disposition of a portion of sales taxes collected for hotel occupancy in cities having a population of one million or more

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- l Section 1. Section 1261 of the tax law is amended by adding a new subdivision (h) to read as follows:
- NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF STATE OR LOCAL LAW, ORDINANCE OR PURSUANT RESOLUTION TO THE CONTRARY, FROM THE MONEYS COLLECTED TWELVE HUNDRED TEN OF THIS ARTICLE FOR THE RENT OF EVERY OCCU-PANCY OF A ROOM OR ROOMS, AS DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION (E) OF SECTION 7 ELEVEN HUNDRED FIVE OF THIS CHAPTER, IN A CITY HAVING A POPULATION OF 8 ONE MILLION OR MORE, FOUR PERCENT OF SUCH MONEYS OR THEFIRST HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS OF SUCH MONEYS COLLECTED DURING EACH CALENDAR 9 YEAR, WHICHEVER SHALL BE LESS, IN EACH BOROUGH OF 10 SUCH CITY SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO A SEPARATE ACCOUNT BY THE COMMISSIONER WITH THE MONEYS IN 11 SUCH ACCOUNT BEING EXPENDED SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROMOTING 12 13 TOURISM IN THE BOROUGH TO WHICH EACH ACCOUNT RELATES. THE MONEYS IN EACH ACCOUNT SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR TOURISM PROMOTION 14 PURPOSES, SIVE OF ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES, TO AN ENTITY DESIGNATED BY THE BOROUGH 15 16 PRESIDENT AND APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT 17 RESPONSIBLE FOR TOURISM PROMOTION IN THE BOROUGH.
- 18 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-19 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
