- AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to enacting the "veterinary emergency response and mobility act of 2015"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "veterinary 2 emergency response and mobility act of 2015".

3 S 2. Section 6705 of the education law is amended by adding two new 4 subdivisions 14 and 15 to read as follows:

5 14. A VETERINARIAN WHO IS LICENSED IN ANOTHER STATE, AND WHO IS IN б GOOD STANDING IN SUCH STATE, PROVIDING SERVICES DIRECTLY IN CONNECTION 7 WITH AN INVESTIGATION BY LAW ENFORCEMENT OF AN ALLEGED VIOLATION OF 8 FEDERAL OR STATE ANIMAL FIGHTING OR ANIMAL CRUELTY LAWS, WITHIN THE 9 SCOPE OF THE INVESTIGATION AND/OR ANY RELATED JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS, 10 SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS: (A) AN OFFICIAL INVITATION HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO THE VETERINARIAN FOR A SPECIFIED PERIOD OF TIME BY THE 11 12 LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY WITH JURISDICTION OVER THE INVESTIGATION; AND 13 SUCH LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY DETERMINES THAT THE VETERINARIAN (B) POSSESSES SKILLS, TRAINING, OR EXPERIENCE NECESSARY AND RELEVANT TO SUCH 14 INVESTIGATION OF ALLEGED INCIDENTS OF ANIMAL FIGHTING OR ANIMAL CRUELTY. 15 16 SUCH EXEMPTION SHALL NOT EXTEND BEYOND THE TIME PERIOD SPECIFIED BY THE 17 LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY WITH JURISDICTION OVER SUCH INVESTIGATION. THE 18 ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY SHALL NOTIFY THE STATE VETERINARIAN OF ANY LAW

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INVESTIGATION CONDUCTED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION FOR THE PURPOSES OF 1 2 FACILITATING APPROPRIATE ANIMAL DISEASE CONTROL MEASURES, IF NECESSARY, 3 PURSUANT TO ARTICLES FIVE AND TWENTY-SIX OF THE AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS 4 LAW. ANY PERSON PRACTICING AS A VETERINARIAN IN NEW YORK STATE PURSUANT 5 то THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE PERSONAL AND SUBJECT MATTER 6 JURISDICTION AND DISCIPLINARY AND REGULATORY AUTHORITY OF THE BOARD OF 7 IF HE OR SHE IS A LICENSEE AND AS IF THE EXEMPTION PURSUANT REGENTS AS 8 TO THIS SUBDIVISION IS A LICENSE. SUCH INDIVIDUAL SHALL COMPLY WITH APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THE RULES OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS, AND THE REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSIONER, RELATING TO PROFESSIONAL MISCONDUCT, 9 10 DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS AND PENALTIES FOR PROFESSIONAL MISCONDUCT. 11

15. A VETERINARIAN WHO IS LICENSED IN ANOTHER STATE, AND WHO IS IN 12 GOOD STANDING IN SUCH STATE, PROVIDING SERVICES DURING AN EMERGENCY 13 OR 14 NATURAL DISASTER WITHIN THE SCOPE AND LOCATION OF ASSIGNED VETERINARY 15 MEDICAL DUTIES OF THE RESPONSE EFFORTS IF: (A) AN OFFICIAL DECLARATION OF THE DISASTER OR EMERGENCY HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR OR THE DELEG-16 ATED STATE OFFICIAL; AND (B) AN OFFICIAL INVITATION HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO 17 VETERINARIAN FOR A SPECIFIED TIME BY THE AUTHORITY THAT HAS JURIS-18 THE 19 DICTION FOR COORDINATING THE ANIMAL/AGRICULTURAL ISSUES IN THE STATE 20 DURING EMERGENCIES EITHER WITHIN OR OUTSIDE THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT 21 ASSISTANCE COMPACT (EMAC). ANY PERSON PRACTICING AS A VETERINARIAN IN 22 YORK STATE PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE NEW PERSONAL AND SUBJECT MATTER JURISDICTION AND DISCIPLINARY AND REGULATORY 23 24 AUTHORITY OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS AS IF HE OR SHE IS A LICENSEE AND AS 25 THE EXEMPTION PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION IS A LICENSE. SUCH INDI-IF VIDUAL SHALL COMPLY WITH APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THE RULES OF THE BOARD 26 OF REGENTS, AND THE REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSIONER, RELATING TO PROFES-27 28 SIONAL MISCONDUCT, DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS AND PENALTIES FOR PROFES-29 SIONAL MISCONDUCT.

30 S 3. Subdivision 3 of section 6712 of the education law, as amended by 31 chapter 333 of the laws of 1990, is amended and two new subdivisions 4 32 and 5 are added to read as follows:

33 3. Any student engaging in clinical practice under the supervision of 34 a licensed veterinarian in pursuance of an approved program for the 35 training of veterinary technology[.];

A TECHNICIAN WHO IS LICENSED IN ANOTHER STATE, AND WHO IS IN GOOD 37 STANDING IN SUCH STATE, PROVIDING VETERINARY TECHNOLOGY SERVICES OTHER-38 WISE PERMISSIBLE PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE DIRECTLY IN CONNECTION WITH AN INVESTIGATION BY LAW ENFORCEMENT OF AN ALLEGED VIOLATION OF FEDERAL OR 39 40 ANIMAL FIGHTING OR ANIMAL CRUELTY LAWS, WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE STATE INVESTIGATION AND/OR ANY RELATED JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS, SUBJECT 41 ΤO THE REQUIREMENTS: (A) AN OFFICIAL INVITATION HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO 42 FOLLOWING 43 THE TECHNICIAN FOR A SPECIFIED PERIOD OF TIME BY THE LAW ENFORCEMENT WITH JURISDICTION OVER THE INVESTIGATION; AND (B) SUCH LAW 44 AUTHORITY 45 ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY DETERMINES THAT THE TECHNICIAN POSSESSES SKILLS, TRAINING, OR EXPERIENCE NECESSARY AND RELEVANT TO SUCH INVESTIGATION OF 46 47 ALLEGED INCIDENTS OF ANIMAL FIGHTING OR ANIMAL CRUELTY. SUCH EXEMPTION 48 SHALL NOT EXTEND BEYOND THE TIME PERIOD SPECIFIED BY THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY WITH JURISDICTION OVER SUCH INVESTIGATION. THE LAW ENFORCEMENT 49 50 SHALL NOTIFY THE STATE VETERINARIAN OF ANY INVESTIGATION AUTHORITY 51 CONDUCTED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION FOR THE PURPOSES OF FACILITATING ANIMAL DISEASE CONTROL MEASURES, IF NECESSARY, PURSUANT TO 52 APPROPRIATE 53 ARTICLES FIVE AND TWENTY-SIX OF THE AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS LAW. ANY PERSON PRACTICING AS A VETERINARY TECHNICIAN IN NEW YORK STATE PURSUANT 54 55 TO THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE PERSONAL AND SUBJECT MATTER 56 JURISDICTION AND DISCIPLINARY AND REGULATORY AUTHORITY OF THE BOARD OF 1 REGENTS AS IF HE OR SHE IS A LICENSEE AND AS IF THE EXEMPTION PURSUANT 2 TO THIS SUBDIVISION IS A LICENSE. SUCH INDIVIDUAL SHALL COMPLY WITH 3 APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THE RULES OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS, AND THE 4 REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSIONER, RELATING TO PROFESSIONAL MISCONDUCT, 5 DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS AND PENALTIES FOR PROFESSIONAL MISCONDUCT.

5. A TECHNICIAN WHO IS LICENSED IN ANOTHER STATE, AND WHO IS 6 IN GOOD 7 STANDING IN SUCH STATE, PROVIDING VETERINARY TECHNOLOGY SERVICES OTHER-WISE PERMISSIBLE PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE DURING AN EMERGENCY OR NATURAL 8 DISASTER WITHIN THE SCOPE AND LOCATION OF ASSIGNED VETERINARY TECHNICIAN 9 10 DUTIES OF THE RESPONSE EFFORTS IF: (A) AN OFFICIAL DECLARATION OF THE DISASTER OR EMERGENCY HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR OR THE DELEGATED 11 12 STATE OFFICIAL; AND (B) AN OFFICIAL INVITATION HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO THE TECHNICIAN FOR A SPECIFIED TIME BY THE AUTHORITY THAT HAS JURISDICTION 13 14 FOR COORDINATING THE ANIMAL/AGRICULTURAL ISSUES IN THE STATE DURING EMERGENCIES EITHER WITHIN OR OUTSIDE THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE 15 COMPACT (EMAC). ANY PERSON PRACTICING AS A VETERINARY TECHNICIAN IN NEW 16 YORK STATE PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE PERSONAL 17 AND SUBJECT MATTER JURISDICTION AND DISCIPLINARY AND REGULATORY AUTHORI-18 19 TY OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS AS IF HE OR SHE IS A LICENSEE AND AS IF THE EXEMPTION PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION IS A LICENSE. SUCH INDIVIDUAL 20 21 SHALL COMPLY WITH APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THE RULES OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS, AND THE REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSIONER, RELATING TO PROFES-22 SIONAL MISCONDUCT, DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS AND PENALTIES FOR PROFES-23 24 SIONAL MISCONDUCT.

25 S 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
