AN ACT to amend the canal law, in relation to maintaining bridges in a manner to not impede commerce, transportation of students, or agriculture

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 62 of the canal law, as amended by chapter 335 of the laws of 2001, is amended to read as follows:

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2 S 62. Maintenance by state of certain bridges over the canal system. All highway or pedestrian, lift or movable bridges over the canal system other than highway bridges connecting parts of a state highway heretofore constructed as a part of the barge canal improvement shall 7 reconstructed, improved, maintained and repaired at the expense of the state, [if in the opinion of the commissioner of transportation, 9 public convenience requires such bridges to be maintained where no alternate crossing has been provided] IN A MANNER SO AS $\,$ NOT $\,$ TO $\,$ IMPEDE 10 COMMERCE, TRANSPORTATION OF STUDENTS, OR AGRICULTURE. In the event the 11 12 commissioner of transportation determines that any such bridge 13 longer required for the convenience of the public, he shall have power to close, remove or relocate such bridge, PROVIDED AT LEAST ONE 14 15 HEARING SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN THE COMMUNITY OR COMMUNITIES WHERE THE 16 BRIDGE TO BE CLOSED OR REMOVED IS LOCATED. The commissioner of 17 portation shall have the supervision and direction of such reconstruction, improvement, maintenance, repair, closing, removing or 18 cation. All bridges over the canal system other than lift, movable, 19 pedestrian or state highway bridges heretofore constructed as part of 20 the barge canal improvement shall be reconstructed, improved, maintained 21 22 repaired at the expense of the state under the supervision and 23 direction of the commissioner of transportation, if, in his opinion, the 24 public convenience requires that each such bridge shall be continued as

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a bridge for highway traffic. In the event the commissioner of transportation is requested by any municipality to reconstruct or improve any such bridge, he is hereby empowered to do so, provided, however, that prior to such reconstruction or improvement the municipality enters into 5 a written agreement that such bridge thereafter shall become a part of 6 the highway system or systems which it may connect and the maintenance, 7 repair, improvement, replacement or closing of any such bridge shall be 8 governed by the provisions of the highway law, except that any such bridges situate in a city shall be maintained, repaired, improved, 9 10 replaced or closed in the same manner and subject to the provisions of any special law which may apply or to the same provisions of law as 11 apply to other streets and bridges in such city or in the case of such 12 13 bridges situate in a village, such bridges shall be maintained, 14 repaired, improved, replaced or closed in the same manner and subject to 15 the same provisions of law as apply to other streets and bridges in such 16 village. Any bridge over the New York state canal system or abandoned part thereof which joins parts of a state highway shall be under the 17 18 jurisdiction of the commissioner of transportation and deemed to be part 19 of the state highway system and such bridges shall be constructed, reconstructed, improved, maintained, repaired, 20 closed or relocated 21 pursuant to the provisions of the highway law and the cost of such 22 shall be paid from moneys available for construction, reconstruction, improvement, maintenance or repair of state highways. 23

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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
