AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to requiring the commissioner to update a licensee's photo image at least every eight years

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 6 of section 502 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by section 3 of part K of chapter 59 of the laws of 2009, is amended to read as follows:

A license issued pursuant to subdivision five of this section shall be valid until the expiration date contained thereon, unless license is suspended, revoked or cancelled. Such license may be renewed by submission of an application for renewal, the fee prescribed by 7 proofs of prior licensing, fitness and acceptable vision prescribed by 9 the commissioner, the applicant's social security number, required by the commissioner a photo image of the applicant in such 10 numbers and form as the commissioner shall prescribe. 11 THECOMMISSIONER EVERY EIGHT YEARS, UPDATE A LICENSEE'S PHOTO 12 SHALL, AT A MINIMUM OF IMAGE AND SHALL PROVIDE LICENSEES WITH THE OPTION OF SUBMITTING 13 PHOTO IMAGE ELECTRONICALLY IN A MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMISSIONER AT 14 ADDITIONAL COST TO THE LICENSEE. In addition, an applicant for 15 16 renewal of a license containing a hazardous material endorsement 17 pass an examination to retain such endorsement. The commissioner shall, 18 with respect to the renewal of a hazardous materials endorsement, comply 19 with the requirements imposed upon states by sections 383.141 1572.13 of title 49 of the code of federal regulations. A renewal of 20 such license shall be issued by the commissioner upon approval of such 21 22 application, except that no such license shall be issued if its issuance 23 would be inconsistent with the provisions of section five hundred 24 sixteen of this title, and except that the commissioner may refuse to

renew such license if the applicant is the holder of a currently valid or renewable license to drive issued by another state or foreign country unless the applicant surrenders such license.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the timely implementation of this act on its effective date are authorized and directed to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
