THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subsection (i) of section 3216 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new paragraph 33 to read as follows:
- (33) EVERY POLICY WHICH PROVIDES MEDICAL, MAJOR MEDICAL, COMPREHENSIVE TYPE COVERAGE SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR PROSTHETIC DEVICES, INCLUDING REPAIRS AND REPLACEMENTS, THAT ARE INTENDED MEDICALLY NECESSARY REHABILITATIVE AND HABILITATIVE PURPOSES AS REQUIRED 42 U.S.C. 18022. AS SUCH, PROSTHETIC DEVICE COVERAGE SHALL BE SUBJECT TO ANNUAL DEDUCTIBLES AND COINSURANCE AS DEEMED APPROPRIATE SUPERINTENDENT IN AMOUNTS NO GREATER THAN OTHER ESSENTIAL HEALTH BENEFITS COVERED BY THE POLICY. THE TERM "PROSTHETIC DEVICE" AS USED PARAGRAPH INCLUDES AN ARTIFICIAL LIMB AND ALL THE COMPONENTS AND RELATED SERVICES THAT COMPRISE PROSTHETIC CARE BUT SHALL NOT INCLUDE

  - (QQ) EVERY POLICY WHICH PROVIDES MEDICAL, MAJOR MEDICAL, OR SIMILAR COMPREHENSIVE TYPE COVERAGE SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR PROSTHETIC DEVICES, INCLUDING REPAIRS AND REPLACEMENTS, THAT ARE INTENDED FOR MEDICALLY NECESSARY REHABILITATIVE AND HABILITATIVE PURPOSES AS REQUIRED 42 U.S.C. S 18022. AS SUCH, PROSTHETIC DEVICE COVERAGE SHALL BE SUBJECT TO ANNUAL DEDUCTIBLES AND COINSURANCE AS DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE SUPERINTENDENT IN AMOUNTS NO GREATER THAN OTHER ESSENTIAL HEALTH BENEFITS COVERED BY THE POLICY.
