AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to extending the authority of the department of environmental conservation to manage crabs

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Subdivision 7 of section 13-0331 of the environmental  
2     conservation law, as amended by chapter 289 of the laws of 2011, is  
3     amended to read as follows:  
4     7. The department may, until December thirty-first, two thousand  
5     [fifteen] SEVENTEEN, fix by regulation measures for the management of  
6     crabs of any kind including horseshoe crabs (*Limulus* sp.), including  
7     size limits, catch and possession limits, open and closed seasons,  
8     closed areas, restrictions on the manner of taking and landing, require-  
9     ments for permits and eligibility therefor, recordkeeping requirements,  
10    requirements on the amount and type of fishing effort and gear, and  
11    requirements relating to transportation, possession and sale, provided  
12    that such regulations are no less restrictive than requirements set  
13    forth in this chapter and provided further that such regulations are  
14    consistent with the compliance requirements of applicable fishery  
15    management plans adopted by the Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commis-  
16    sion and with applicable provisions of fishery management plans adopted  
17    pursuant to the Federal Fishery Conservation and Management Act (16  
18    U.S.C. S 1800 et seq.).  
19    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
