AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to certified school psychologists and special education services and programs for preschool children with handicapping conditions; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph d of subdivision 6 of section 4410 of the education law, as added by chapter 581 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read as follows:

PART-TIME

Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the exemption in subdivision one of section seventy-six hundred five of this chapter shall apply to persons employed [by] ON A FULL-TIME OR PART-TIME SALARY BASIS, WHICH MAY INCLUDE ON AN HOURLY, WEEKLY, OR MONTHLY ON A FEE FOR EVALUATION SERVICES BASIS PROVIDED THAT SUCH PERSON IS EMPLOYED BY AND UNDER THE DOMINION AND CONTROL OF a center-based program approved pursuant to subdivision nine of this section as a CERTIFIED school psychologist to provide activities, services and use of the title psychologist to students enrolled in such approved center-based program; TO CERTIFIED SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS EMPLOYED ON A FULL-TIME OR PART-TIME SALARY BASIS, WHICH MAY INCLUDE ON AN HOURLY, BASIS, OR ON A FEE FOR EVALUATION SERVICES BASIS PROVIDED THAT THE SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST IS EMPLOYED BY THEAND UNDER DOMINION AND CONTROL OF A PROGRAM THAT HAS BEEN APPROVED PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH B OF SUBDIVISION NINE OF THIS SECTION, OR SUBDIVISION NINE-A OF THIS SECTION, TO CONDUCT A MULTI-DISCIPLINARY EVALUATION OF A PRESCHOOL CHILD HAVING OR SUSPECTED OF HAVING A DISABILITY WHERE AUTHORIZED BY PARAGRAPH A OR B SUBDIVISION SIX OF SECTION SIXTY-FIVE HUNDRED THREE-B OF THIS CHAP-OF TER; AND TO CERTIFIED SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS EMPLOYED ON A FULL-TIME

NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE 9 CONSTRUED TO AUTHORIZE A CERTIFIED SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST OR GROUP OF SUCH 10 SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS TO ENGAGE IN INDEPENDENT PRACTICE OR PRACTICE 11 OUTSIDE OF AN EMPLOYMENT RELATIONSHIP.

- S 2. Subdivision 1 of section 7605 of the education law, as added by chapter 987 of the laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:
- The activities, services, and use of the title of psychologist, or 15 any derivation thereof, on the part of a person in the employ of a federal, state, county or municipal agency, or other political subdivision, or a chartered elementary or secondary school or degree-granting educational institution insofar as such activities and services are a 19 part of the duties of his salaried position; OR ON THE PART OF A PERSON EMPLOY AS A CERTIFIED SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST ON A FULL-TIME OR THEPART-TIME SALARY BASIS, WHICH MAY INCLUDE ON AN HOURLY, MONTHLY BASIS, OR ON A FEE FOR EVALUATION SERVICES BASIS PROVIDED THAT SUCH PERSON EMPLOYED AS A CERTIFIED SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST IS EMPLOYED BY UNDER THE DOMINION AND CONTROL OF A PRESCHOOL SPECIAL EDUCATION PROGRAM APPROVED PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH B OF SUBDIVISION NINE OR SUBDIVI-SION NINE-A OF SECTION FORTY-FOUR HUNDRED TEN OF THIS CHAPTER TO PROVIDE ACTIVITIES, SERVICES AND TO USE THE TITLE 27 "CERTIFIED SCHOOL PSYCHOL-OGIST", SO LONG AS THIS SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PERMIT THE USE OF THE TITLE "LICENSED PSYCHOLOGIST", TO STUDENTS ENROLLED IN SUCH APPROVED PROGRAM OR TO CONDUCT A MULTIDISCIPLINARY EVALUATION OF A PRESCHOOL CHILD HAVING OR SUSPECTED OF HAVING A DISABILITY; OR ON THE PART OF A PERSON IN THE EMPLOY AS A CERTIFIED SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST ON A FULL-TIME OR PART-TIME SALARY BASIS, WHICH MAY INCLUDE ON AN HOURLY, MONTHLY BASIS, OR ON A FEE FOR EVALUATION SERVICES BASIS PROVIDED THAT SUCH PERSON EMPLOYED AS A CERTIFIED SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST IS EMPLOYED UNDER THE DOMINION AND CONTROL OF AN AGENCY APPROVED IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE TWO-A OF ARTICLE TWENTY-FIVE OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW EARLY INTERVENTION PROGRAM MULTIDISCIPLINARY EVALUATIONS, DELIVER SERVICE COORDINATION SERVICES AND EARLY INTERVENTION PROGRAM SERVICES, EACH SUCH PRESCHOOL SPECIAL EDUCATION PROGRAM OR EARLY INTER-VENTION PROVIDER IS AUTHORIZED BY PARAGRAPH A OR B OF SUBDIVISION SIX OF SECTION SIXTY-FIVE HUNDRED THREE OF THIS TITLE, EACH IN THE COURSE 43 THEIR EMPLOYMENT. NOTHING IN THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO 44 AUTHORIZE A CERTIFIED SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST OR GROUP OF SUCH PSYCHOLOGISTS TO ENGAGE IN INDEPENDENT PRACTICE OR PRACTICE OUTSIDE OF AN EMPLOYMENT RELATIONSHIP.
- 47 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately and shall be deemed to 48 have been in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2014, provided, 49 however that the provisions of this act shall expire and be deemed 50 repealed June 30, 2016.
