AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to creating a public education initiative designed to eliminate stigma and misinformation about mental illness and chemical dependence among military service members; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 7.09 of the mental hygiene law is amended by adding 2 a new subdivision (k) to read as follows:
- 3 (K) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY GENERAL OR SPECIAL LAW TO THE CONTRARY, THE 4 COMMISSIONER, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE COMMISSIONER OF ALCOHOLISM AND 5 SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES AND THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF VETERANS'
- 6 AFFAIRS SHALL DEVELOP A PUBLIC EDUCATION INITIATIVE DESIGNED TO ELIMI-7 NATE STIGMA AND MISINFORMATION ABOUT MENTAL ILLNESS AND CHEMICAL DEPEND-
- 8 ENCE AMONG SERVICE MEMBERS, VETERANS, AND THEIR FAMILIES, IMPROVE THEIR
- 9 UNDERSTANDING OF MENTAL AND SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS AND THE EXISTENCE OF
- 10 EFFECTIVE TREATMENT, AND PROVIDE INFORMATION REGARDING AVAILABLE 11 RESOURCES AND HOW TO ACCESS THEM. THESE PUBLIC EDUCATION INITIATIVES MAY
- 12 INCLUDE THE USE OF THE INTERNET, INCLUDING THE USE OF SOCIAL NETWORKING
- 13 SITES.
- 14 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire on June
- 15 30, 2018 when upon such date the provisions of this act shall be deemed
- 16 repealed.
