- AN ACT to authorize Richard Insogna, Jr. to take the competitive civil service examination and be placed on the eligible list for appointment as a full-time police officer for the village of Fort Plain, county of Montgomery

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 58 of the civil 1 service law, or any other law to the contrary, Richard Insogna, Jr., who 2 3 has been continuously employed by the village of Fort Plain, in the county of Montgomery, as a part-time police officer, shall be eligible 4 5 take the competitive civil service examination for the position of to 6 police officer and shall, contingent upon his score on such examination, 7 be eligible to be placed on the eligible list for appointment as a fulltime police officer for the village of Fort Plain. 8

9 S 2. Richard Insogna, Jr. shall otherwise be subject to the merit and 10 fitness provisions of the civil service law applicable to full-time 11 police officers.

12 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
