AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring students in grade twelve to take an annual hearing examination

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 905 of the education law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 6 to read as follows:
- 6. ANY CHILD ENTERING OR HAVING ENTERED TWELFTH GRADE OR A COMPARABLE AGE LEVEL SPECIAL EDUCATION PROGRAM WITH AN UNASSIGNED GRADE, AND INCLUDING THOSE CHILDREN WHO ARE HOMESCHOOLED, SHALL TAKE AN ANNUAL EXAMINATION FOR HEARING.
- 7 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
