AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to the appointment of members of the battery park city authority

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 1973 of the public authorities law, as amended by chapter 766 of the laws of 2005, is amended to read as follows:

- (1) There is hereby created the battery park city authority which shall be a body corporate and politic, constituting a public benefit 5 corporation. Its membership shall consist of seven members to be 6 7 appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the senate. IF LESS THAN A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE AUTHORITY ARE RESIDENTS 9 THE COMMUNITY DISTRICT IN WHICH BATTERY PARK CITY IS LOCATED, THE GOVER-SHALL APPOINT A RESIDENT OF THE COMMUNITY DISTRICT IN WHICH BATTERY 10 11 PARK CITY IS LOCATED. One of the members first appointed shall serve for a term ending four years from January first next succeeding his appoint-12 ment; one of such members shall serve for a term ending five years from 13 14 such date; and one of such members shall serve for a term ending six 15 years from such date. Provided, however, that two board members appointed on or after the effective date of [the] chapter SEVEN HUNDRED 16 SIXTY-SIX of the laws of two thousand five [which amended this 17 sion] shall serve an initial term of two years; provided further that 18 19 two other board members first appointed on or after the effective date 20 chapter SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX of the laws of two thousand [the] 21 five [which amended this subdivision] shall serve an initial term of 22 Their successors shall serve for terms of six years each. four years. 23 Members shall continue in office until their successors have been appointed and qualified and the provisions of section thirty-nine of the 24 25 public officers law shall apply. In the event of a vacancy occurring in the office of a member by death, resignation or otherwise, the governor 26 27 shall appoint a successor with the advice and consent of the senate to serve for the balance of the unexpired term. 28
