amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to AN ACT to authorizing the on premise sale of alcoholic beverages on Sunday mornings

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 5 of section 106 of the alcoholic beverage control law, as amended by chapter 83 of the laws of 1995, is amended to read as follows:
  - (a) Sunday, from four ante meridiem to twelve noon, EXCEPT PURSUANT TO SECTION NINETY-NINE-H OR SECTION NINETY-NINE-I OF THIS CHAPTER.

- The alcoholic beverage control law is amended by adding a new 7 section 99-h to read as follows:
  - S 99-H. ANNUAL PERMIT TO REMAIN OPEN DURING CERTAIN HOURS OF THE MORN-ING. 1. ANY PERSON LICENSED TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR CONSUMPTION THE PREMISES PURSUANT TO THIS CHAPTER OR ANY APPLICANT FOR AN ORIGINAL LICENSE TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR CONSUMPTION ON PREMISES PURSUANT TO THIS CHAPTER MAY APPLY TO THE LIQUOR AUTHORITY FOR AN ANNUAL PERMIT TO REMAIN OPEN ON SUNDAY BETWEEN THE HOURS O'CLOCK A.M. AND NOON. ANY APPLICANT FOR SUCH AN ANNUAL PERMIT SHALL PROVIDE NOTICE TO THE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY OF SUCH APPLICATION AS PROVIDED IN SECTION ONE HUNDRED TEN-B OF THIS CHAPTER.
- 2. THE ANNUAL FEE FOR SUCH ANNUAL PERMIT SHALL BE 17 TWO HUNDRED THE COUNTIES OF NEW YORK, KINGS, BRONX AND QUEENS; ONE 18 DOLLARS ΙN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS IN THE COUNTY OF RICHMOND AND IN CITIES 19 HAVING A 20 POPULATION OF MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND AND LESS THAN ONE MILLION; 21 ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS IN CITIES HAVING A POPULATION OF MORE THAN 22 THOUSAND AND LESS THAN ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND; AND THE SUM OF FIFTY DOLLARS ELSEWHERE. 23

- 4 S 3. The alcoholic beverage control law is amended by adding a new 5 section 99-i to read as follows:
  - S 99-I. SPECIAL PERMIT TO REMAIN OPEN DURING CERTAIN HOURS OF THE MORNING. 1. ANY PERSON LICENSED TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES PURSUANT TO THIS CHAPTER MAY APPLY TO THE LIQUOR AUTHORITY FOR A SPECIAL PERMIT TO REMAIN OPEN SUNDAY BETWEEN THE HOURS OF EIGHT O'CLOCK A.M. AND NOON. THE FEE FOR SUCH PERMIT SHALL BE FIFTY DOLLARS PER DAY.
- 12 2. SUCH PERMITS AND THE EXERCISE OF THE PRIVILEGES GRANTED THEREUNDER 13 ARE SUBJECT TO SUCH RULES AS THE LIQUOR AUTHORITY MAY DEEM NECESSARY.
- 14 S 4. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 15 have become a law.
