AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to requiring regulations to establish a method of notification of WIC reimbursement rejections and the reason for such rejection and prohibits fees for rejected or bounced WIC checks

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 206 of the public health law is amended by adding two new paragraphs (v) and (w) to read as follows:
- (V) BY RULE AND REGULATION, ESTABLISH A METHOD IN WHICH THE DEPARTMENT NOTIFIES VENDORS AUTHORIZED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SPECIAL SUPPLEMENTAL FOOD PROGRAM FOR WOMEN, INFANTS, AND CHILDREN (WIC PROGRAM), OF THE REJECTION OF A REIMBURSEMENT SUBMITTED BY THE VENDOR AND THE REASON FOR SUCH REJECTION.
- 8 (W) BY RULE AND REGULATION ESTABLISH A METHOD WHEREBY THE VENDOR IS 9 RESPONSIBLE ONLY FOR THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE TOTAL SUBMITTED FOR 10 REIMBURSEMENT AND THE REDEMPTION VALUE OF THE WIC CHECK. VENDORS SHALL 11 NOT BE RESPONSIBLE TO PAY A FEE FOR REJECTED OR BOUNCED WIC CHECKS.
 - S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
