AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to tinted or shaded windows of motor vehicles

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subparagraph 4 of paragraph (b) of subdivision 12-a of section 375 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 155 of the laws of 1991, is amended to read as follows:

- (4) the rear window of which is composed of, covered by or treated with any material which has a light transmittance of less than seventy percent. [A rear window may have a light transmittance of less than seventy percent if the vehicle is equipped with side mirrors on both sides of the vehicle so adjusted that the driver thereof shall have a clear and full view of the road and condition of traffic behind such vehicle.]
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed12 ing the date on which it shall have become a law; provided that the
 13 commissioner of motor vehicles is authorized to promulgate any and all
 14 rules and regulations necessary and take any other measures necessary to
 15 implement this act on its effective date on or before such date.
