- AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to requiring applicants for health insurance offered through the state health benefit exchange be provided space on the application for such insurance to register for the donate life registry for organ, eye and tissue donations

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 206 of the public health law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph (v) to read as follows:

3 (V) REQUIRE, IN CONSULTATION AND COOPERATION WITH THE SUPERINTENDENT 4 OF FINANCIAL SERVICES, THAT EVERY INDIVIDUAL APPLYING FOR HEALTH CARE 5 COVERAGE THROUGH THE STATE HEALTH BENEFIT EXCHANGE ESTABLISHED PURSUANT 6 PATIENT PROTECTION AND AFFORDABLE CARE ACT TO THE FEDERAL (P.L. 7 111-148), AS AMENDED BY THE FEDERAL HEALTH CARE AND EDUCATION RECONCIL-8 IATION ACT OF 2010 (P.L. 111-152), BE PROVIDED SPACE SO THAT SUCH APPLI-CANT MAY REGISTER IN THE "DONATE LIFE REGISTRY" FOR ORGAN, EYE AND 9 10 TISSUE DONATIONS UNDER SECTION FORTY-THREE HUNDRED TEN OF THIS CHAPTER WITH THE FOLLOWING STATED IN CLEAR CONSPICUOUS TYPE: 11

12 "WOULD YOU LIKE TO BE ADDED TO THE DONATE LIFE REGISTRY? CHECK BOX 13 FOR 'YES' OR 'SKIP THIS QUESTION'."

THE COMMISSIONER SHALL NOT MAINTAIN RECORDS OF ANY PERSON WHO CHECKS 14 15 "SKIP THIS QUESTION". EXCEPT WHERE THE APPLICATION IS MADE IN PERSON OR ELECTRONICALLY, FAILURE TO CHECK A BOX SHALL NOT IMPAIR THE VALIDITY OF 16 17 AN APPLICATION, AND FAILURE TO CHECK "YES" OR CHECKING "SKIP THIS QUES-TION" SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO IMPLY A WISH NOT TO DONATE. IN THE CASE 18 AN APPLICANT UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE, CHECKING "YES" SHALL NOT 19 OF CONSTITUTE CONSENT TO MAKE AN ANATOMICAL GIFT OR REGISTRATION IN THE 20 21 DONATE LIFE REGISTRY. WHERE AN APPLICANT HAS PREVIOUSLY CONSENTED TO 22 MAKE AN ANATOMICAL GIFT OR REGISTERED IN THE DONATE LIFE REGISTRY, 23 CHECKING "SKIP THIS OUESTION" OR FAILING TO CHECK A BOX SHALL NOT IMPAIR 24 THAT CONSENT OR REGISTRATION.

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1 S 2. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 5 of section 4310 of the public 2 health law, as amended by section 27 of part A of chapter 60 of the laws 3 of 2014, is amended to read as follows:

4 (a) Such organ, eye and tissue registration of consent to make an 5 anatomical gift can be made through: (i) indication made on the application or renewal form of a driver's license, (ii) indication made on a б non-driver identification card application or renewal form, (iii) indi-7 8 cation made on a voter registration form pursuant to subdivision five of section 5-210 of the election law, (iv) INDICATION MADE ON THE 9 APPLICA-10 TION FOR HEALTH CARE COVERAGE OFFERED THROUGH THE STATE HEALTH BENEFIT 11 EXCHANGE, (V) enrollment through the donate life registry website, [(v)] (VI) paper enrollment submitted to the donate life registry, 12 or [(vi)] (VII) through any other method identified by the commissioner. 13

14 S 3. Subparagraph (i) of paragraph (b) of subdivision 5 of section 15 4310 of the public health law, as amended by section 27 of part A of 16 chapter 60 of the laws of 2014, is amended to read as follows:

(i) Where required by law for registration forms described in subparagraphs (i) [and], (ii) AND (IV) of paragraph (a) of this subdivision, the commissioner shall ensure that space is provided on any registration form so that the applicant shall register or decline registration in the donate life registry for organ, eye and tissue donations under this section and that the following is stated on the form in clear and conspicuous type:

"You must fill out the following section: Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'."

S 4. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-27 28 ing the date on which it shall have become a law. Provided, that, effec-29 tive immediately, any actions necessary to implement the provisions of this act on its effective date are authorized and directed to be 30 completed on or before such date. Provided, further, that the amendments 31 32 subdivision 5 of section 4310 of the public health law, made by to 33 sections two and three of this act, shall not affect the expiration of such subdivision, and shall expire and be deemed repealed therewith. 34
