AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in  
relation to signage in school speed zones

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Paragraph 1 of subdivision e of section 19-177 of the  
2     administrative code of the city of New York, as added by local law  
3     number 24 of the city of New York for the year 2014, is amended to read  
4     as follows:  
5     (1) Except as provided in paragraph two of this subdivision, the  
6     commissioner shall establish speed limits of not less than fifteen nor  
7     more than twenty miles per hour at fifty school locations annually, for  
8     a distance not to exceed one thousand three hundred twenty feet, on  
9     highways passing any school building, entrance or exit of a school abut-  
10    ting on the highway. THE OFFICIAL SIGNS POSTED AT EACH SCHOOL LOCATION  
11    THAT HAS BEEN SELECTED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL INCLUDE THE  
12    REDUCED SPEED LIMIT, FLASHING BEACONS, AND A NOTICE THAT THE REDUCED  
13    SPEED LIMIT IS IN EFFECT WHEN SUCH BEACONS ARE FLASHING. For purposes of  
14    this subdivision, the term "school" shall have the same meaning as in  
15    section 19-189 of this title.  
16    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
