AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to suspending the registration of a vehicle which has been documented five times by a photo violation monitoring device for failure of an operator thereof to comply with traffic-control indications

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new  
2 section 1118 to read as follows:  
3 S 1118. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAL. THE REGISTRA-  
4 TION OF A VEHICLE WHICH HAS BEEN DOCUMENTED FIVE TIMES WITHIN A TWELVE  
5 MONTH PERIOD BY A PHOTO VIOLATION MONITORING DEVICE FOR FAILURE OF AN  
6 OPERATOR THEREOF TO COMPLY WITH TRAFFIC-CONTROL INDICATIONS SHALL BE  
7 SUSPENDED FOR A PERIOD OF SIX MONTHS COMMENCING FIVE DAYS AFTER THE  
8 NOTICE OF LIABILITY FOR THE FIFTH VIOLATION HAS BEEN MAILED; PROVIDED,  
9 HOWEVER, THAT THIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO A RENTAL VEHICLE, AS  
10 DEFINED IN SECTION ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN-A OF THIS CHAPTER.  
11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
