THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 364-j of the social services law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 26-b to read as follows:

26-B. NO MANAGED CARE PROVIDER SHALL REQUIRE PRIOR AUTHORIZATION FOR
 ANY PRESCRIPTION OR RENEWAL THEREOF FOR THE DISPENSING OF BUPRENORPHINE
 WHICH IS PRESCRIBED AS A TREATMENT FOR OPIOID ADDICTION.

6 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately, provided that the amend-7 ment to section 364-j of the social services law, made by section one of 8 this act, shall not affect the expiration and repeal of such section, 9 and shall expire and be deemed repealed therewith.
