AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to creating a presumption of intent to sell

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 220.26 to 2 read as follows:
- 3 S 220.26 PRESUMPTION OF INTENT TO SELL.
- FOR THE PURPOSES OF A PROSECUTION OF A CHARGE UNDER SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION 220.16 OF THIS ARTICLE, THE POSSESSION OF FIFTY OR MORE INDIVID-
- 6 UAL PACKAGES CONTAINING THE CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE DEFINED UNDER PARAGRAPH
- 7 ELEVEN OF SUBDIVISION (C) OF SCHEDULE I OF SECTION THIRTY-THREE HUNDRED
- 8 SIX OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW AND/OR THE POSSESSION OF SUCH CONTROLLED
- 9 SUBSTANCE IN AN AMOUNT HAVING AN AGGREGATE VALUE OF THREE HUNDRED
- 10 DOLLARS OR MORE, IS PRESUMPTIVE EVIDENCE THAT SUCH PERSON POSSESSED SUCH
- 11 CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE WITH INTENT TO SELL IT.
- 12 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall
- 13 have become a law.
