AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to work experience

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 336-c of the social services law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:
- 3 5. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, SERVICES OFFICIAL MAY NOT RECOVER PUBLIC ASSISTANCE PROPERLY PAID AS 5 PERMITTED UNDER SECTIONS ONE HUNDRED FOUR, ONE HUNDRED FOUR-B, ONE 6 HUNDRED SIX, ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-ONE-R AND SUBDIVISION THREE OF SECTION 7 ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-EIGHT OF THIS CHAPTER OR ANY OTHER PROVISION OF 8 WHERE A RECIPIENT OR FORMER RECIPIENT OF SUCH ASSISTANCE WAS TITLE, 9 REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN A WORK EXPERIENCE PROGRAM UNDER THIS 10 WITHOUT FIRST CREDITING AGAINST SUCH RECOVERY THE NUMBER OF HOURS THAT SUCH PERSON ACTUALLY PARTICIPATED IN A WORK EXPERIENCE 11 PROGRAM MULTI-PLIED BY THE HIGHER OF THE APPLICABLE STATE OR FEDERAL MINIMUM WAGE. 12 13 NOTHING IN THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL ALTER THE RULES GOVERNING AND DEFI-EXPERIENCE PROGRAMS AS ENUMERATED IN SUBDIVISIONS ONE, 14 WORK 15 TWO, THREE AND FOUR OF THIS SECTION. THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL APPLY ONLY NUMBER OF HOURS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE WORK EXPERIENCE PROGRAM 16 AND SHALL NOT APPLY TO ANY OTHER ACTIVITY FOR WHICH A 17 SOCIAL 18 DISTRICT HAS REQUIRED A RECIPIENT OR FORMER RECIPIENT TO PARTICIPATE IN, 19 INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT OR REHABILI-
- 21 S 2. Effective immediately, the office of temporary and disability 22 assistance shall promulgate rules and regulations, and conduct any 23 requisite training necessary for the implementation of this act.
