AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to requiring reasonable efforts be made to clear motor vehicles of accumulated snow and ice

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new 2 section 1229-e to read as follows:
 - S 1229-E. CLEARANCE OF ACCUMULATED SNOW AND ICE. 1. A MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR SHALL MAKE REASONABLE EFFORTS TO REMOVE ACCUMULATED SNOW OR ICE ON SUCH MOTOR VEHICLE, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE WINDSHIELD, WINDOWS, HOOD, TRUNK AND ROOF OF SUCH MOTOR VEHICLE, BEFORE OPERATING THE MOTOR VEHICLE ON ANY STREET OR HIGHWAY OF THIS STATE IN ORDER TO NOT POSE A THREAT TO OTHER PERSONS OR PROPERTY. ANY OPERATOR WHO VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE FINED SEVENTY-FIVE DOLLARS.

AN OPERATOR OF A NON-COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE WHO VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION WHERE SUCH VIOLATION RESULTS IN THE 11 INJURY OR DAMAGE TO THE PROPERTY OF ANOTHER PERSON, SHALL BE FINED NOT 12 13 LESS THAN TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS NOR MORE THAN ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS EACH OFFENSE. AN OPERATOR OF A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE WHO VIOLATES THE 14 15 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION WHERE SUCH VIOLATION RESULTS IN THE PERSONAL INJURY OR DAMAGE TO THE PROPERTY OF ANOTHER PERSON, 16 SHALL BE FINED NOT LESS HUNDRED DOLLARS NOR MORE THAN TWELVE HUNDRED FIFTY 17 THAN FIVE
- 18 DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE.
