AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to requiring the court, prior to accepting a plea to a misdemeanor or violation, to advise the defendant of the risk of deportation if he or she is not a citizen

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 340.20 of the criminal procedure law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:

- 5. PRIOR TO ACCEPTING A DEFENDANT'S PLEA OF GUILTY TO A COUNT OR AN INFORMATION, AS DEFINED BY SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION 340.10 OF THIS ARTICLE, CHARGING A MISDEMEANOR, AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVI-TWO OF SECTION 55.10 OF THE PENAL LAW, OR A VIOLATION, AS DEFINED BY SUBDIVISION THREE OF SECTION 55.10 OF THE PENAL LAW, THE COURT ADVISE THE DEFENDANT THAT IF THE DEFENDANT IS NOT A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, THE DEFENDANT'S PLEA OF GUILTY AND THE COURT'S ACCEPTANCE THEREOF MAY RESULT IN THE DEFENDANT'S DEPORTATION OR REMOVAL, EXCLUSION FROM ADMISSION TO THE UNITED STATES OR DENIAL OF NATURALIZATION PURSUANT TO THE LAWS OF THE UNITED STATES. IN ADDITION, THE COURT SHALL, PRIOR TO SUCH PLEA, ADVISE THE DEFENDANT THAT, IF THE DEFENDANT IS NOT ACCEPTING A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES AND IS OR BECOMES THE SUBJECT OF A FINAL REMOVAL ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT, THE DEFENDANT MAY BE RELEASED TO THE CUSTODY OF THEIMMI-GRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT FOR REMOVAL PURPOSES AS A RESULT OF THE DEFENDANT'S PLEA OF GUILTY. THE COURT SHALL, CONTEMPORANEOUS AFFIRM ON THE RECORD OR IN A WRITING THAT THE DEFENDANT HAS BEEN GIVEN THE NOTICE REQUIRED BY THIS SUBDIVISION.
- 21 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 22 have become a law.
