- AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the offenses of aggravated assault upon a person less than ten years old and criminal use of a firearm in the second degree

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as 2 "Luisito's law".

3 S 2. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 1 of section 70.02 of the penal 4 law, as amended by chapter 368 of the laws of 2015, is amended to read 5 as follows:

6 (a) Class B violent felony offenses: an attempt to commit the class 7 A-I felonies of murder in the second degree as defined in section 8 125.25, kidnapping in the first degree as defined in section 135.25, and 9 arson in the first degree as defined in section 150.20; manslaughter in the first degree as defined in section 125.20, aggravated manslaughter in the first degree as defined in section 125.22, rape in the first 10 11 degree as defined in section 130.35, criminal sexual act in the first 12 13 degree as defined in section 130.50, aggravated sexual abuse in the first degree as defined in section 130.70, course of sexual conduct 14 15 against a child in the first degree as defined in section 130.75; assault in the first degree as defined in section 120.10, kidnapping in 16 second degree as defined in section 135.20, burglary in the first 17 the degree as defined in section 140.30, arson in the second degree as 18 19 defined in section 150.15, robbery in the first degree as defined in 20 section 160.15, sex trafficking as defined in paragraphs (a) and (b) of 21 subdivision five of section 230.34, incest in the first degree as

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defined in section 255.27, criminal possession of a weapon in the first 1 degree as defined in section 265.04, criminal use of a firearm in the 2 3 first degree as defined in section 265.09, criminal sale of a firearm in 4 the first degree as defined in section 265.13, aggravated assault upon a police officer or a peace officer as defined in section 120.11, gang assault in the first degree as defined in section 120.07, AGGRAVATED 5 6 7 ASSAULT UPON A PERSON LESS THAN TEN YEARS OLD AS DEFINED IN SECTION 8 120.12-A, intimidating a victim or witness in the first degree as defined in section 215.17, hindering prosecution of terrorism in the 9 10 first degree as defined in section 490.35, criminal possession of a 11 chemical weapon or biological weapon in the second degree as defined in 12 section 490.40, and criminal use of a chemical weapon or biological weapon in the third degree as defined in section 490.47. 13 14 S 3. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 120.12-a to read as follows: 15 16 S 120.12-A AGGRAVATED ASSAULT UPON A PERSON LESS THAN TEN YEARS OLD. 17 IS GUILTY OF AGGRAVATED ASSAULT UPON A PERSON LESS THAN TEN PERSON А 18 YEARS OLD WHEN, BEING EIGHTEEN YEARS OLD OR OLDER, WITH INTENT TO CAUSE 19 PHYSICAL INJURY TO ANOTHER PERSON, HE OR SHE CAUSES SUCH INJURY TO A 20 CHILD LESS THAN TEN YEARS OLD BY MEANS OF A DEADLY WEAPON OR DANGEROUS 21 INSTRUMENT. 22 AGGRAVATED ASSAULT UPON A PERSON LESS THAN TEN YEARS OLD IS A CLASS B 23 FELONY. 24 S 4. Section 265.08 of the penal law, as added by chapter 233 of the 25 laws of 1980, is amended to read as follows: 26 S 265.08 Criminal use of a firearm in the second degree. 27 1. A person is guilty of criminal use of a firearm in the second 28 degree when he OR SHE commits any class C violent felony offense as defined in paragraph (b) of subdivision one of section 70.02 OF THIS 29 CHAPTER, OR HE OR SHE COMMITS A SPECIFIED OFFENSE WHILE KNOWING 30 OR HEIS ON SCHOOL GROUNDS, AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION FOURTEEN OF SECTION 31 SHE 32 220.00 OF THIS PART, OR WITHIN TWO HUNDRED FIFTY FEET OF ANY PLAYGROUND 33 THE CITY OF NEW YORK OR ANY DEPARTMENT OR PUBLIC AUTHORITY OPERATED BY THEREOF, and he OR SHE either: 34 35 [(1)] (A) possesses a deadly weapon, if the weapon is a loaded weapon from which a shot, readily capable of producing death or other serious 36 37 injury may be discharged; or 38 [(2)] (B) displays what appears to be a pistol, revolver, rifle, shot-39 gun, machine gun or other firearm. 40 2. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, A "SPECIFIED OFFENSE" IS AN THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER: 41 OFFENSE DEFINED BY ANY OF SECTION 115.05 (CRIMINAL FACILITATION IN THE SECOND DEGREE), 265.16 (CRIMINAL SALE OF A FIREARM TO A MINOR), 100.13 (CRIMINAL SOLICITATION 42 43 44 IN THE FIRST DEGREE), 155.40 (GRAND LARCENY IN THE SECOND DEGREE),

3 Criminal use of a firearm in the second degree is a class C felony. 4 S 5. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-5 ing the date upon which it shall have become a law.
