AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to requiring a police identification line-up to be conducted sequentially

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 2 of section 240.40 of the 1 criminal procedure law, as added by chapter 412 of the laws of 1979, is 2 3 amended to read as follows:

4 (b) may order the defendant to provide non-testimonial evidence. Such order may, among other things, require the defendant to:

(i) Appear in a SEQUENTIAL line-up, ONE DEFENDANT AT A TIME;

(ii) Speak for identification by witness or potential witness;

(iii) Be fingerprinted;

(iv) Pose for photographs not involving reenactment of an event;

(v) Permit the taking of samples of blood, hair or other materials 10 from his body in a manner not involving an unreasonable intrusion there-11 of or a risk of serious physical injury thereto; 12

(vi) Provide specimens of his handwriting; 13

14 (vii) Submit to a reasonable physical or medical inspection of his body. 15

S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-16 17 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
