AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to waiving civil service examination application fees for veterans

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraphs (c) and (d) of subdivision 5 of section 50 of the civil service law are relettered paragraphs (d) and (e) and a new paragraph (c) is added to read as follows:

- (C) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (A) OF THIS SION, THE CIVIL SERVICE DEPARTMENT, A MUNICIPAL COMMISSION OR A REGIONAL COMMISSION SHALL WAIVE THE APPLICATION FEE OF ANY CANDIDATE WHO PROVES, 7 BY APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTARY PROOF, TO THE CIVIL SERVICE DEPARTMENT, A MUNICIPAL COMMISSION OR A REGIONAL COMMISSION THAT HE OR SHE IS A VETER-PURPOSES OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE TERM "VETERAN" MEANS A 9 FOR THE MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES WHO SERVED THEREIN IN 10 OF WAR, WHO WAS HONORABLY DISCHARGED OR RELEASED UNDER HONORABLE 11 CIRCUMSTANCES FROM SUCH SERVICE, WHO IS A CITIZEN OF THE 12 UNITED 13 OR AN ALIEN LAWFULLY ADMITTED FOR PERMANENT RESIDENCE IN THE UNITED 14 STATES AND WHO IS A RESIDENT OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK AT THE
- 15 APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT.

16 S 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 17 have become a law.
