- AN ACT to amend the judiciary law, in relation to judicial wellness or assistance committees

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The judiciary law is amended by adding a new article 22-A 2 to read as follows: 3

THIS PRIVILEGE SHALL NOT EXTEND TO INFORMATION RECEIVED BY A JUDGE OR LAWYER SERVING AS A MEMBER 15 OF A JUDICIAL WELLNESS OR ASSISTANCE COMMITTEE THAT A JUDGE IS COMMIT-16 TING OR IS LIKELY TO COMMIT A SUBSTANTIAL VIOLATION OF THE RULES GOVERN-17 18 ING JUDICIAL CONDUCT.

AFFAIRS OF, ANY OF THE COMMITTEES REFERRED TO IN SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS
SECTION SHALL BE IMMUNE FROM CIVIL LIABILITY THAT MIGHT OTHERWISE RESULT
BY REASON OF SUCH CONDUCT. FOR THE PURPOSE OF ANY PROCEEDING, THE GOOD

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
