AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to defenses against patronizing a person for prostitution

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 230.07 of the penal law, as amended by chapter 368 of the laws of 2015, is amended to read as follows:

3 S 230.07 Patronizing a person for prostitution; defense.

In any prosecution for patronizing a person for prostitution in the first or second degrees or patronizing a person for prostitution in a school zone, it is [a] AN AFFIRMATIVE defense that the defendant did not have reasonable grounds to believe that the person was less than the age specified.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
