AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to authorizing certain employees represented by a collective bargaining representative to work more than six days a week on a voluntary basis

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 161 of the labor law is amended by
2 adding a new paragraph g to read as follows:

3 G. EMPLOYEES IN A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING UNIT REPRESENTED BY AN EXCLU-
4 SIVE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING REPRESENTATIVE WHO ARE COVERED BY A COLLEC-
5 TIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WHOSE TERMS ALLOW FOR EMPLOYEES TO WORK PURELY
6 VOLUNTARY OVERTIME.

7 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
