AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to meetings and absences of the board of regents

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 204 of the education law is amended to read as 2 follows:

3 S 204. Meetings and absences. 1. (A) The regents may provide for reqular meetings[, and the chancellor, or the commissioner of education, or 4 5 any five regents, may at any time call a special meeting of the board of 6 regents and fix the time and place therefor; and at least ten days' notice of every meeting shall be mailed to the usual address of each 7 8 regent. If any regent shall fail to attend three consecutive meetings, 9 without excuse accepted as satisfactory by the regents, he may be deemed 10 have resigned and the regents shall then report the vacancy to the to legislature, which shall fill it] OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS AND ANY 11 COMMITTEE, SUBCOMMITTEE, TASK FORCE, OR OTHER SUBGROUPS THEREOF. 12 NOTICE PLACE FOR ALL REGULAR PUBLIC MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF 13 OF TIME AND REGENTS AND ANY COMMITTEE, SUBCOMMITTEE, TASK FORCE, OR OTHER SUBGROUPS 14 PUBLICLY PROVIDED AT LEAST SEVEN DAYS IN ADVANCE OF 15 THEREOF SHALL ΒE SUCH MEETING. SUCH NOTICE OF TIME, PLACE AND AGENDA SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED 16 17 VIA THE BOARD'S OFFICIAL INTERNET WEBSITE AND SPECIFICALLY DISTRIBUTED UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE TO ALL REGENTS AT THEIR USUAL ADDRESSES 18 ΒY AND, IF A MEETING OF A COMMITTEE, SUBCOMMITTEE, 19 TASK FORCE, OR OTHER 20 SUBGROUPS THEREOF, BY SUCH MEANS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE OR ELECTRONIC MEANS, AS DETERMINED BY 21 THE TASK FORCE, OR OTHER SUBGROUPS THEREOF. 22 SUBCOMMITTEE, COMMITTEE, AN 23 AGENDA FOR A REGULAR PUBLIC MEETING OF THE BOARD SHALL BE COMPRISED OF A 24 LIST OF ALL ITEMS TO BE CONSIDERED WITH A DESCRIPTION OF THE SUBJECT 25 ITEM AND SHALL BE POSTED AT LEAST THREE DAYS IN MATTER OF EACH SUCH

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1 ADVANCE OF THE MEETING; PROVIDED HOWEVER, THAT IN AN INSTANCE OF A 2 HEALTH OR PUBLIC SAFETY EMERGENCY, THE BOARD MAY INCLUDE ADDITIONAL 3 ITEMS TO THE AGENDA WITH LESS THAN THREE DAYS NOTICE. IN AN INSTANCE OF 4 A HEALTH OR PUBLIC SAFETY EMERGENCY, THE BOARD SHALL USE BEST EFFORTS TO 5 MAKE PUBLIC ANY CHANGES TO THE AGENDA PRIOR TO THE REGULAR MEETING. THE 6 NOTICE AND AGENDA SHALL BE CONSIDERED A PUBLIC RECORD.

7 (B) THE CHANCELLOR OR THE COMMISSIONER, OR ANY FIVE REGENTS, MAY AT 8 ANY TIME CALL A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS AND FIX THE TIME AND PLACE THEREFOR. NOTICE OF TIME, PLACE AND AGENDA FOR ALL SPECIAL 9 10 PUBLIC MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS SHALL BE PUBLICLY PROVIDED AT LEAST THREE DAYS IN ADVANCE OF SUCH MEETING. SUCH NOTICE OF TIME, PLACE 11 AND AGENDA SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED VIA THE BOARD'S OFFICIAL INTERNET 12 WEBSITE AND SPECIFICALLY CIRCULATED ACCORDING TO THE RULES AND REGU-13 14 LATIONS OF THE REGENTS TO ALL REGENTS. THE BOARD OF REGENTS SPECIAL PUBLIC MEETING AGENDA SHALL BE COMPRISED OF A LIST OF ALL ITEMS TO BE 15 16 CONSIDERED WITH A DESCRIPTION OF THE SUBJECT MATTER OF EACH SUCH ITEM; PROVIDED HOWEVER, THAT IN AN INSTANCE OF A HEALTH OR PUBLIC SAFETY EMER-17 GENCY, THE BOARD MAY INCLUDE ADDITIONAL ITEMS TO THE AGENDA WITH LESS 18 19 THAN THREE DAYS NOTICE. IN AN INSTANCE OF A HEALTH OR PUBLIC SAFETY 20 EMERGENCY, THE BOARD SHALL USE BEST EFFORTS TO MAKE PUBLIC ANY CHANGES 21 TO THE AGENDA PRIOR TO THE SPECIAL MEETING. THE NOTICE AND AGENDA SHALL 22 BE CONSIDERED A PUBLIC RECORD.

23 2. ANY MEETING OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS AND ANY COMMITTEE, SUBCOMMIT-24 TEE, TASK FORCE, OR OTHER SUBGROUPS THEREOF SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN 25 ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE SEVEN OF THE PUBLIC OFFICERS LAW.

3. A SUMMARY OF COMMITTEE REPORTS, ANY OTHER MINUTES, AND ATTENDANCE 26 27 OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS FOR EITHER REGULAR OR SPECIAL MEETINGS SHALL BE ELECTRONICALLY AVAILABLE ON THE BOARD OF REGENTS WEBSITE AT THE CLOSE OF 28 EACH BOARD MEETING AND SHALL BE CONSIDERED A PUBLIC RECORD. THE VIDEO 29 RECORDING OF ANY REGULAR FULL BOARD MEETING SHALL BE POSTED NO LATER 30 THAN FIVE DAYS FOLLOWING THE MEETING OF THE BOARD. ANY MEETING SUMMARIES 31 32 AND ACTIONS TAKEN SHALL BE POSTED ON THE BOARD OF REGENTS WEBSITE WITHIN 33 FIVE DAYS OF APPROVAL BY THE BOARD. INFORMATION POSTED ON THE BOARD OF REGENTS WEBSITE SHALL REMAIN ON THE SITE AS ARCHIVED DATA FOR A MINIMUM 34 35 OF TEN YEARS.

4. IF ANY REGENT SHALL FAIL TO ATTEND THREE CONSECUTIVE MEETINGS,
WITHOUT EXCUSE ACCEPTED AS SATISFACTORY BY THE REGENTS, THAT REGENT MAY
BE DEEMED TO HAVE RESIGNED AND THE REGENTS SHALL THEN REPORT THE VACANCY
TO THE LEGISLATURE WHICH SHALL FILL IT.

40 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 41 have become a law.
